LIFE PRACTICES NEEDED TO BE NORMAL AND HEALTHY IN THE CHURCH LIFE (1)

I. Being Revived Daily by Eating

2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart; but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day.

John 6:57b so he who eats Me, he also shall live because of Me.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 4:4 But He answered and said, It is written, "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out through the mouth of God."

II. Living Christ by Walking According to the Spirit

Philippians 1:21 For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life has freed me in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and of death.

Galatians 5:16 But I say, Walk by the Spirit and you shall by no means fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Romans 8:6 For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace.

Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself witnesses with our spirit that we are children of God.

III. Knowing the Word

2 Timothy 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, an unashamed workman, cutting straight the word of the truth.

John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words which I have spoken unto you are spirit and are life.

2 Timothy. 3:15 And that from a babe you have known the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise unto salvation through the faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Acts 1:20 For it is written in the book of Psalms, "Let his habitation become desolate, and let no one dwell in it"; and, "His overseership let another take."

IV. Yearning for Growth

1 Peter 1:23 Having been regenerated, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, through the living and abiding word of God.

Colossians 2:19 And not holding the Head, out from whom all the Body, being richly supplied and knit together by means of the joints and sinews, grows with the growth of God.

Ephesians 4:13 Until we all arrive at the oneness of the faith and of the full knowledge of the Son of God, at a full-grown man, at the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,

V. Seeing the Church

Ephesians 3:10-11

10 In order that now to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenlies the multifarious wisdom of God might be made known through the church,

11 According to the eternal purpose which He made in Christ Jesus our Lord,

Ephesians 5:32 This mystery is great, but I speak with regard to Christ and the church.

Acts 8:1 And Saul approved of his killing. And there occurred in that day a great persecution against the church which was in Jerusalem; and all were scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria,

except the apostles.

Ephesians 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the full knowledge of Him,

1 Corinthians 12:21 And the eye cannot say to the hand, I have no need of you; nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

Hebrews 10:25 Not abandoning our own assembling together, as the custom with some is, but exhorting one another; and so much the more as you see the day drawing near

VI. Longing to Be Absolute

Romans 14:8 For whether we live, we live to the Lord, and whether we die, we die to the Lord. Therefore whether we live or we die, we are the Lord's.

Colossians 3:3 For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

John 4:34 Jesus said to them, My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to finish His work.

2 Corinthians 2:14-16

14 But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in the Christ and manifests the savor of the knowledge of Him through us in every place.

15 For we are a fragrance of Christ to God in those who are being saved and in those who are perishing:

16 To some a savor out of death unto death, and to the others a savor out of life unto life. And who is sufficient for these things?
