C. The Meaning

John 20:1 Now on the first day of the week, Mary the Magdalene came early to the tomb while it was yet dark and saw the stone taken away from the tomb.

John 20:11-14 But Mary stood outside at the tomb weeping. Then as she wept, she stooped to look into the tomb¹² and beheld two angels in white sitting, one at the head and one at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.¹³ And they said to her, Woman, why are you weeping? She said to them, Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him.¹⁴ When she said these things, she turned backward and beheld Jesus standing there...

Matthew 6:6 But you, when you pray, enter into your private room, and shut your door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will repay you.

Exodus 34:2-3 And be ready by the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to Me, on the top of the mountain.³ And no one shall come up with you, nor let anyone be seen anywhere on the mountain, nor let the flocks or herds graze in front of that mountain.
