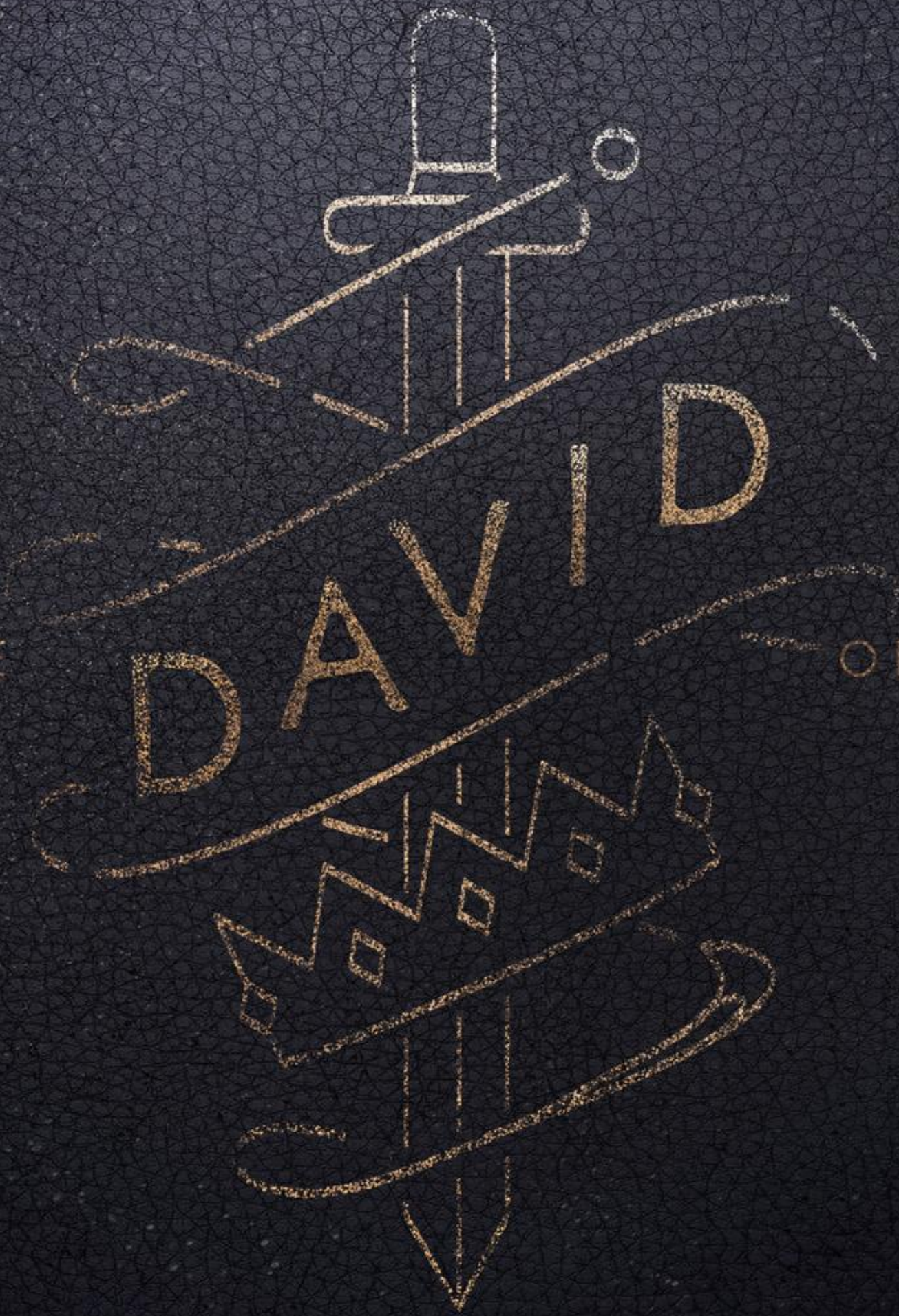

1 CHRONICLES 17:1-2

After David was settled in his palace, he said to Nathan the prophet, “Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of the covenant of the Lord is under a tent.” **2** Nathan replied to David, “Whatever you have in mind, do it, for God is with you.”

1 CHRONICLES 17:3-6

3 But that night the word of God came to Nathan, saying: 4 “Go and tell my servant David, ‘This is what the Lord says: You are not the one to build me a house to dwell in. 5 I have not dwelt in a house from the day I brought Israel up out of Egypt to this day. I have moved from one tent site to another, from one dwelling place to another. 6 Wherever I have moved with all the Israelites, did I ever say to any of their leaders whom I commanded to shepherd my people, “Why have you not built me a house of cedar?”

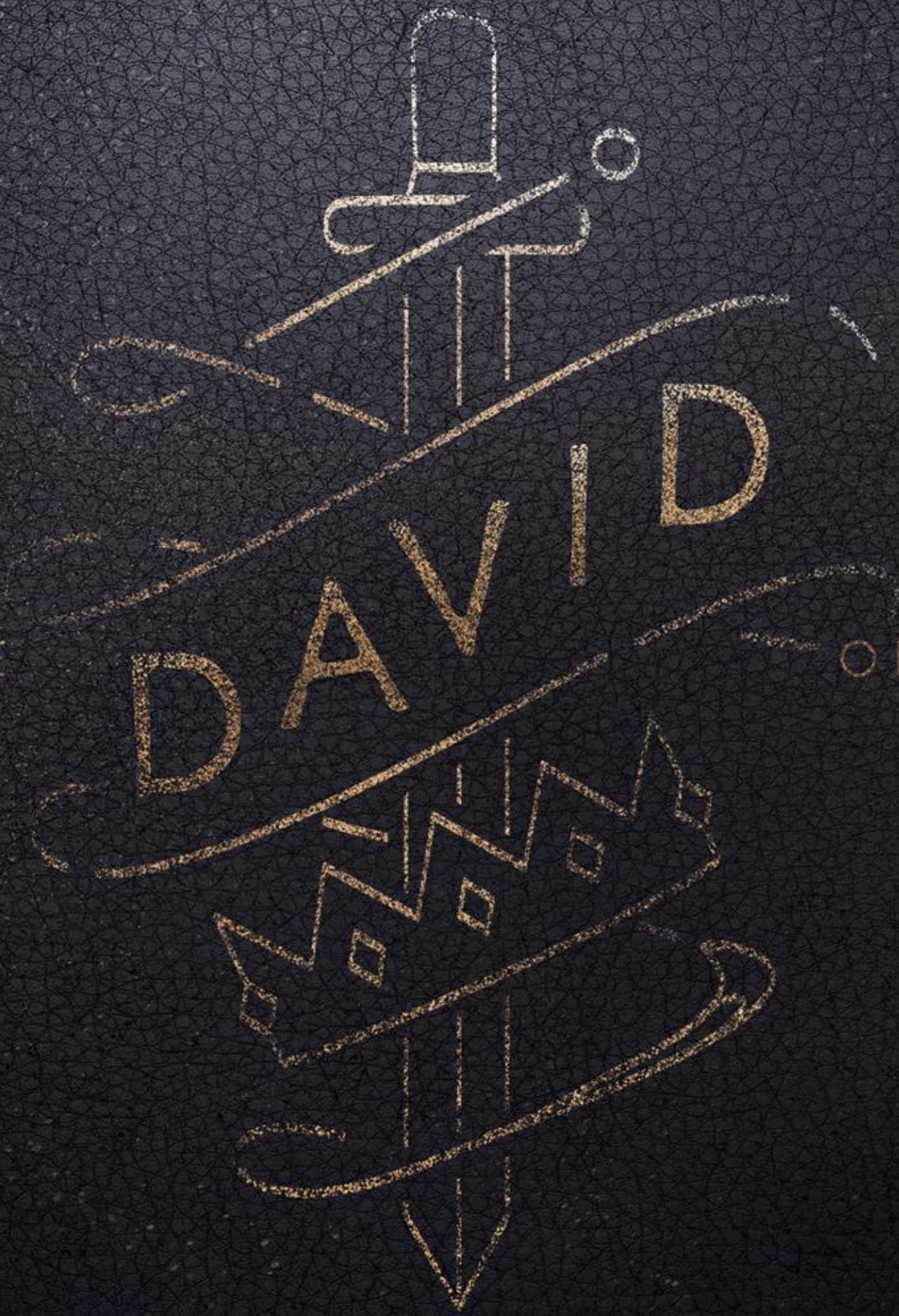
1 CHRONICLES 17 : 7 – 8

I appointed you.

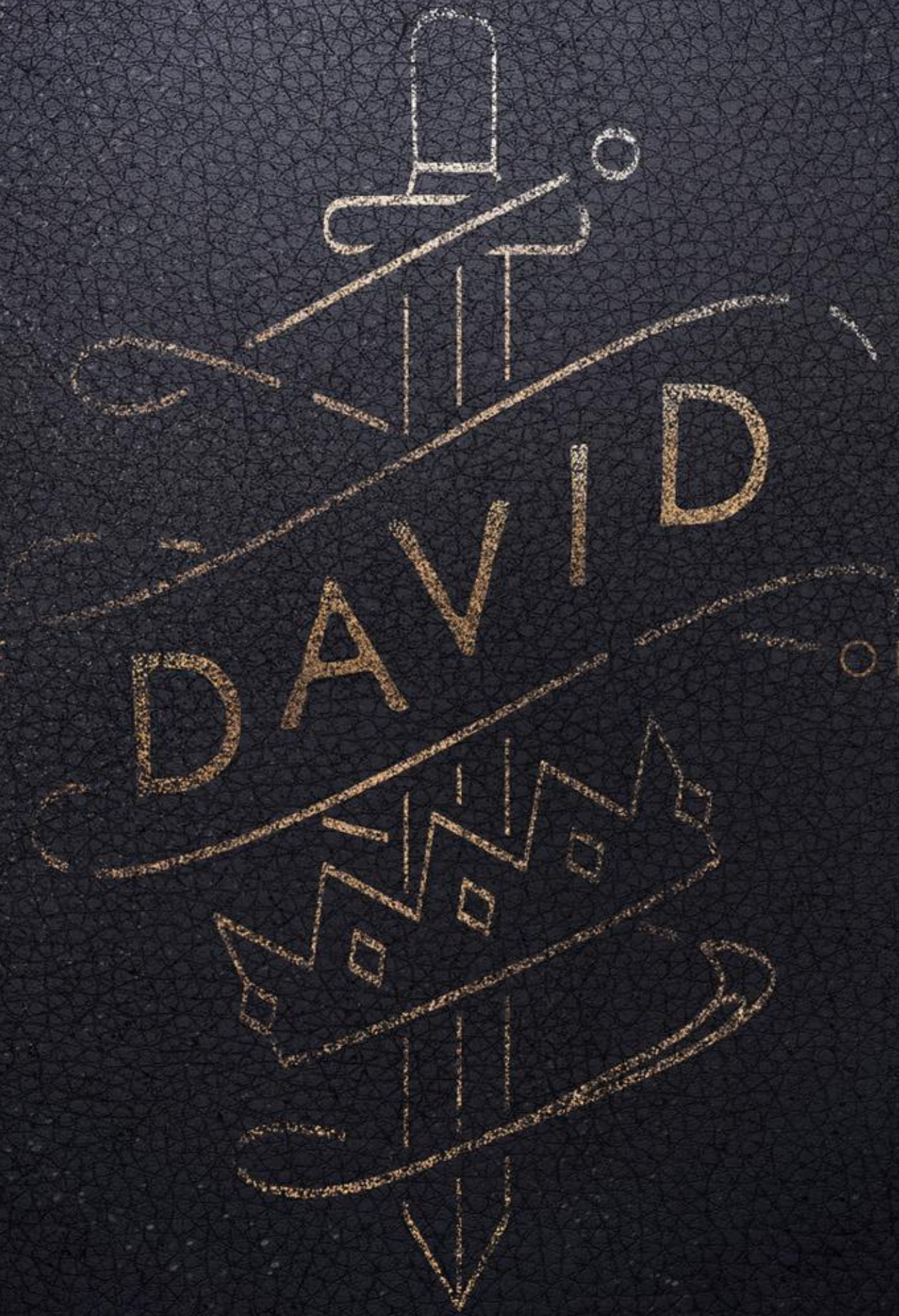
I have been with you.

I will subdue all your enemies.

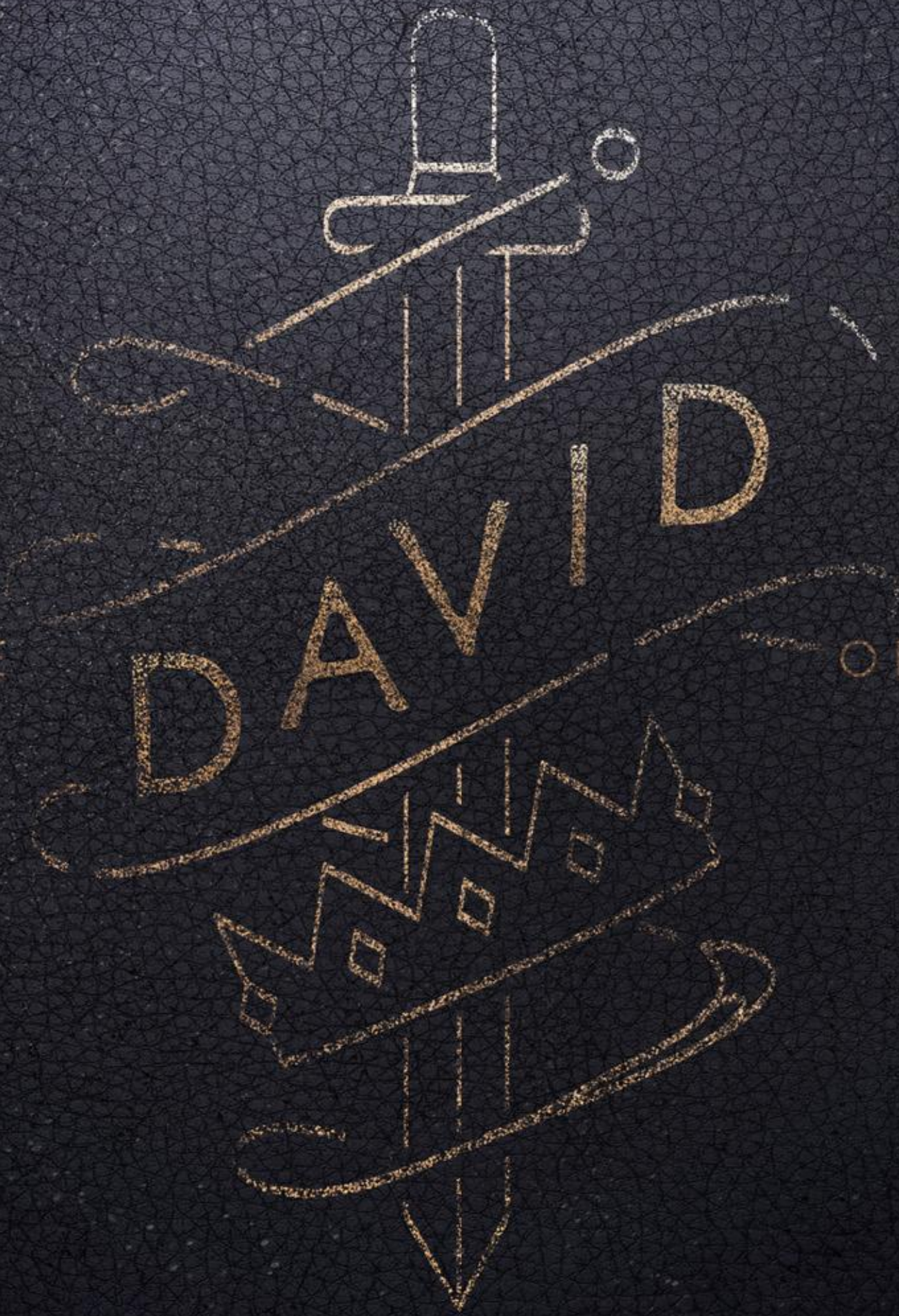

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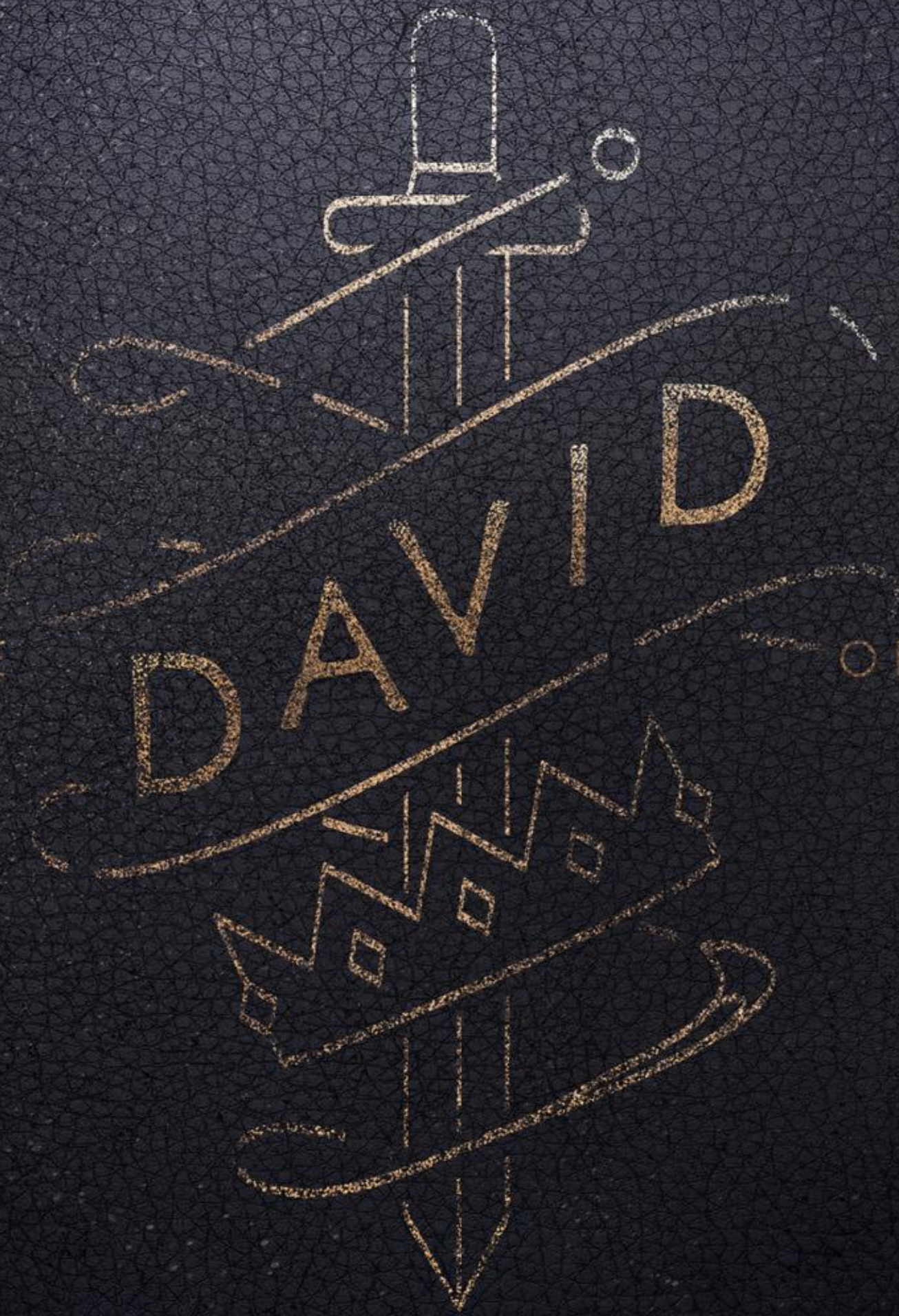
1 CHRONICLES 17:11-14

He will build a house for me, and I will establish his throne forever.

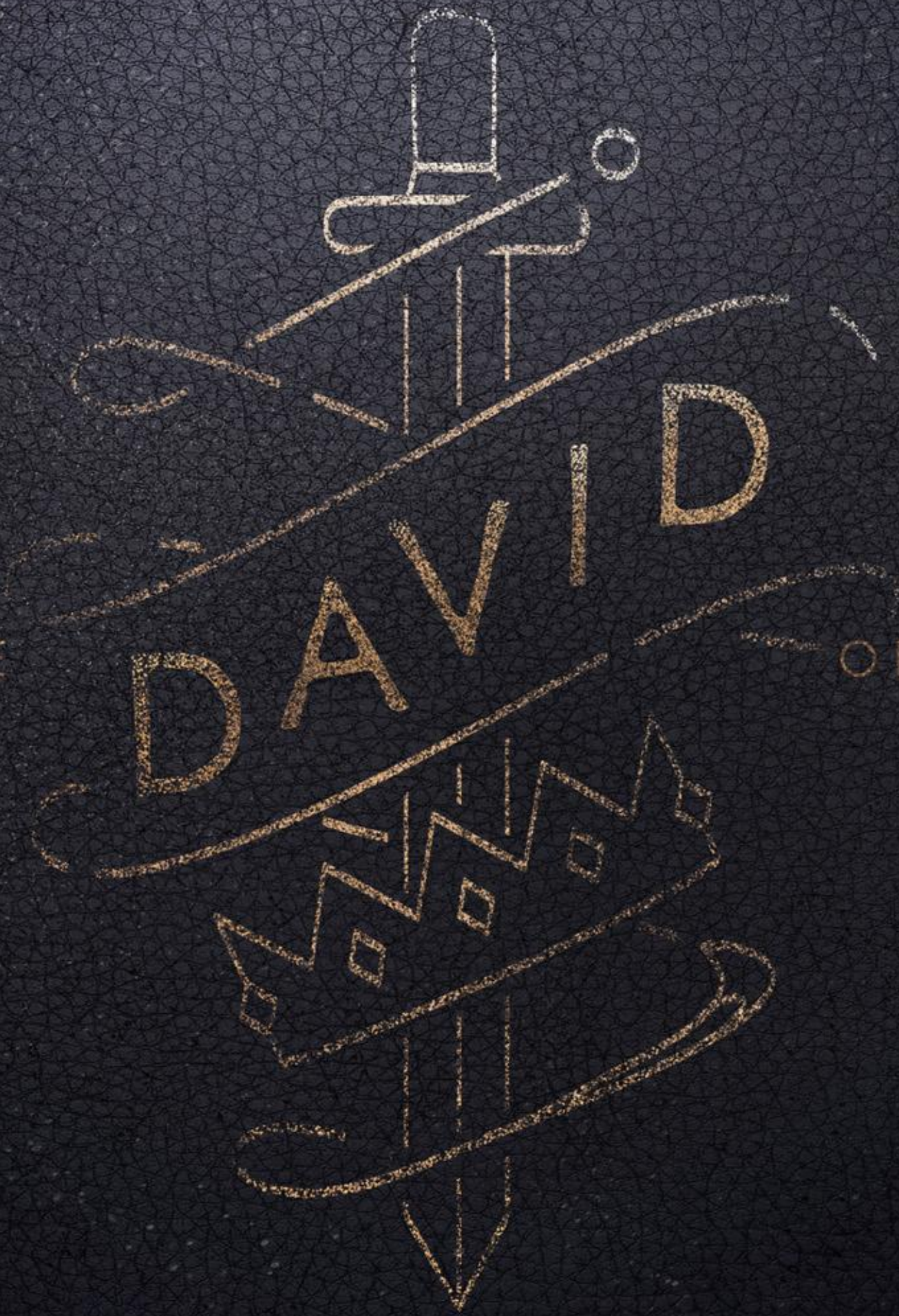
I will be his father, and he will be my son.

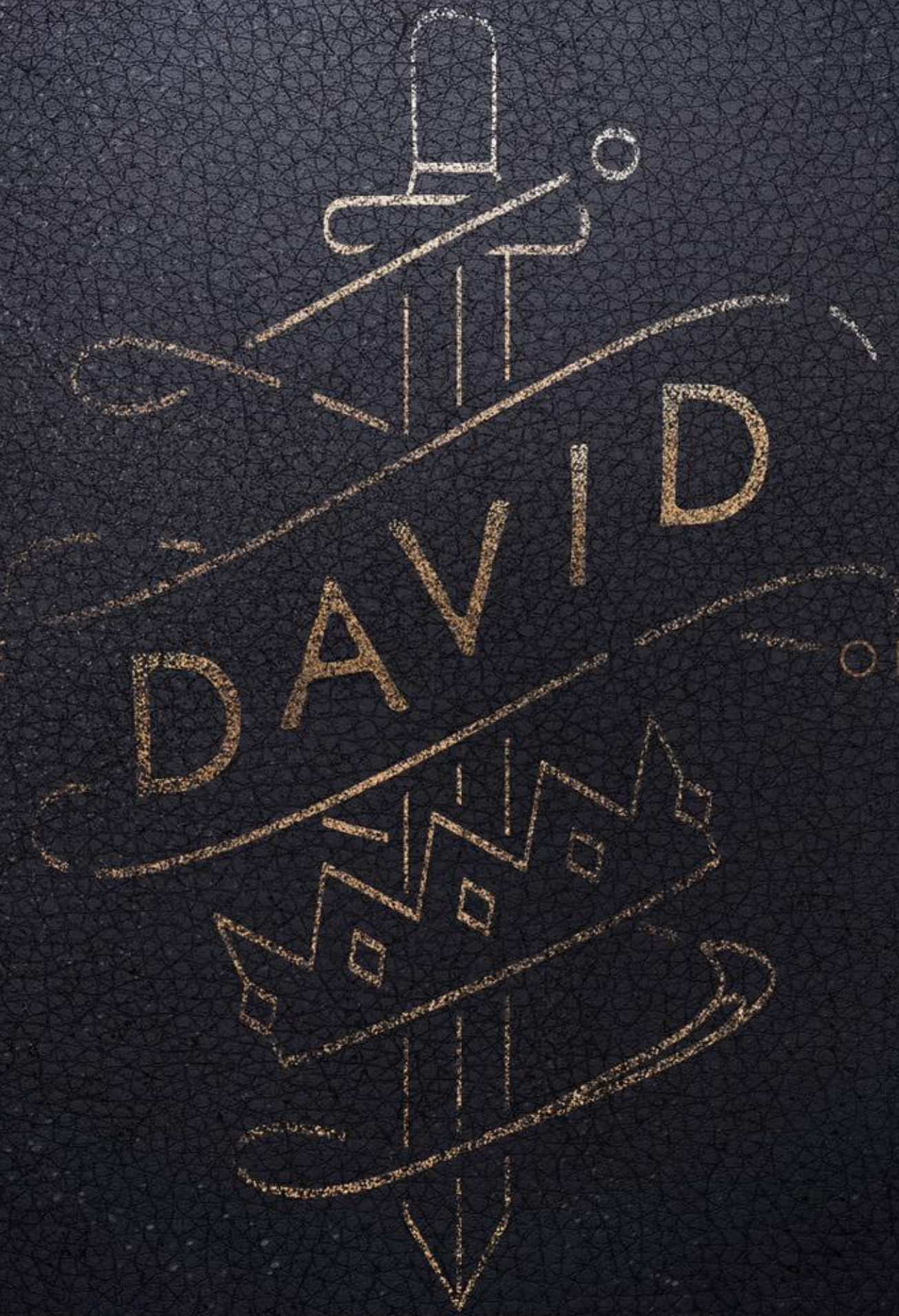

His kingdom did not last forever.

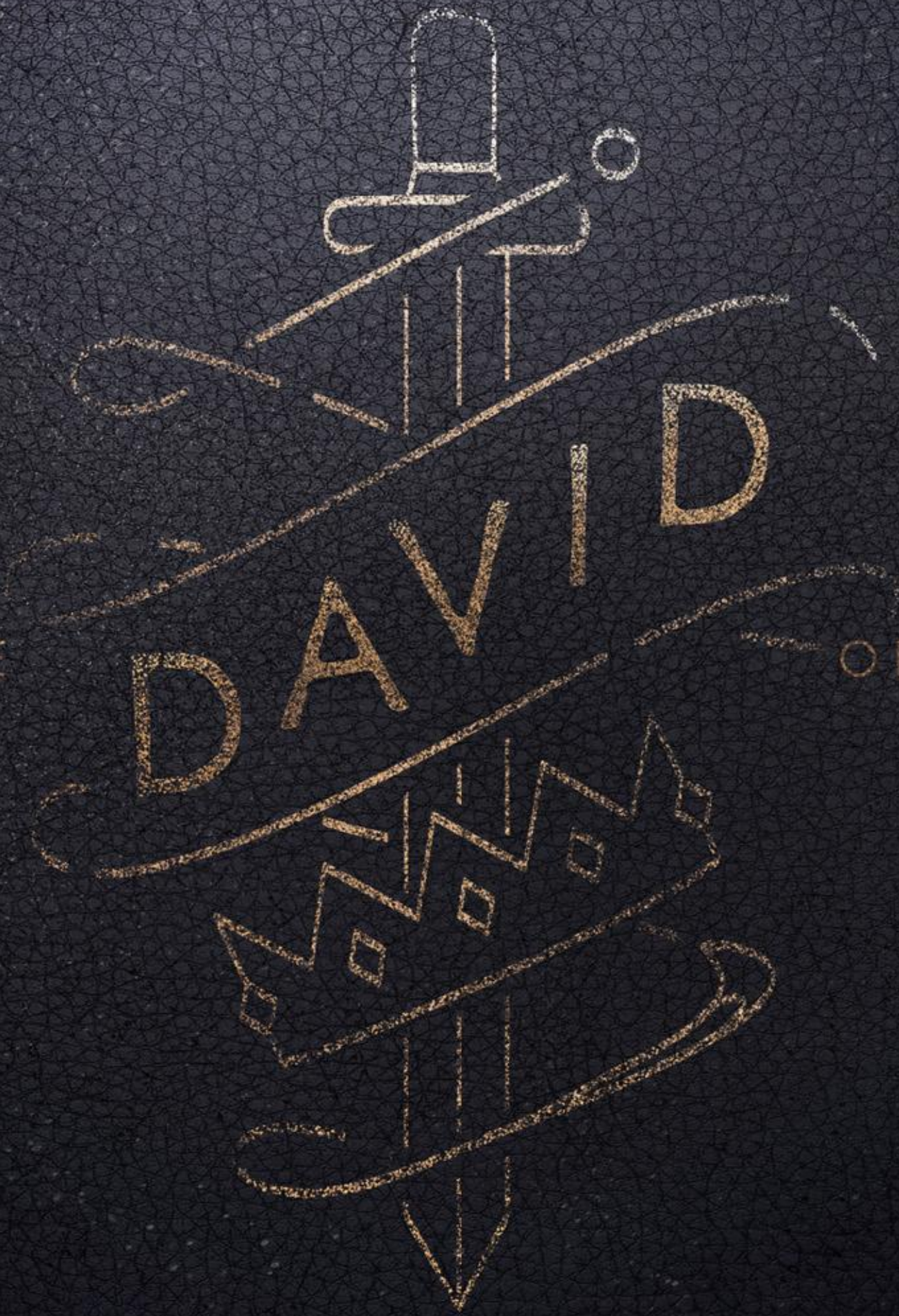
In the end his heart turned away from full devotion to the Lord.

Did God's promise fail?

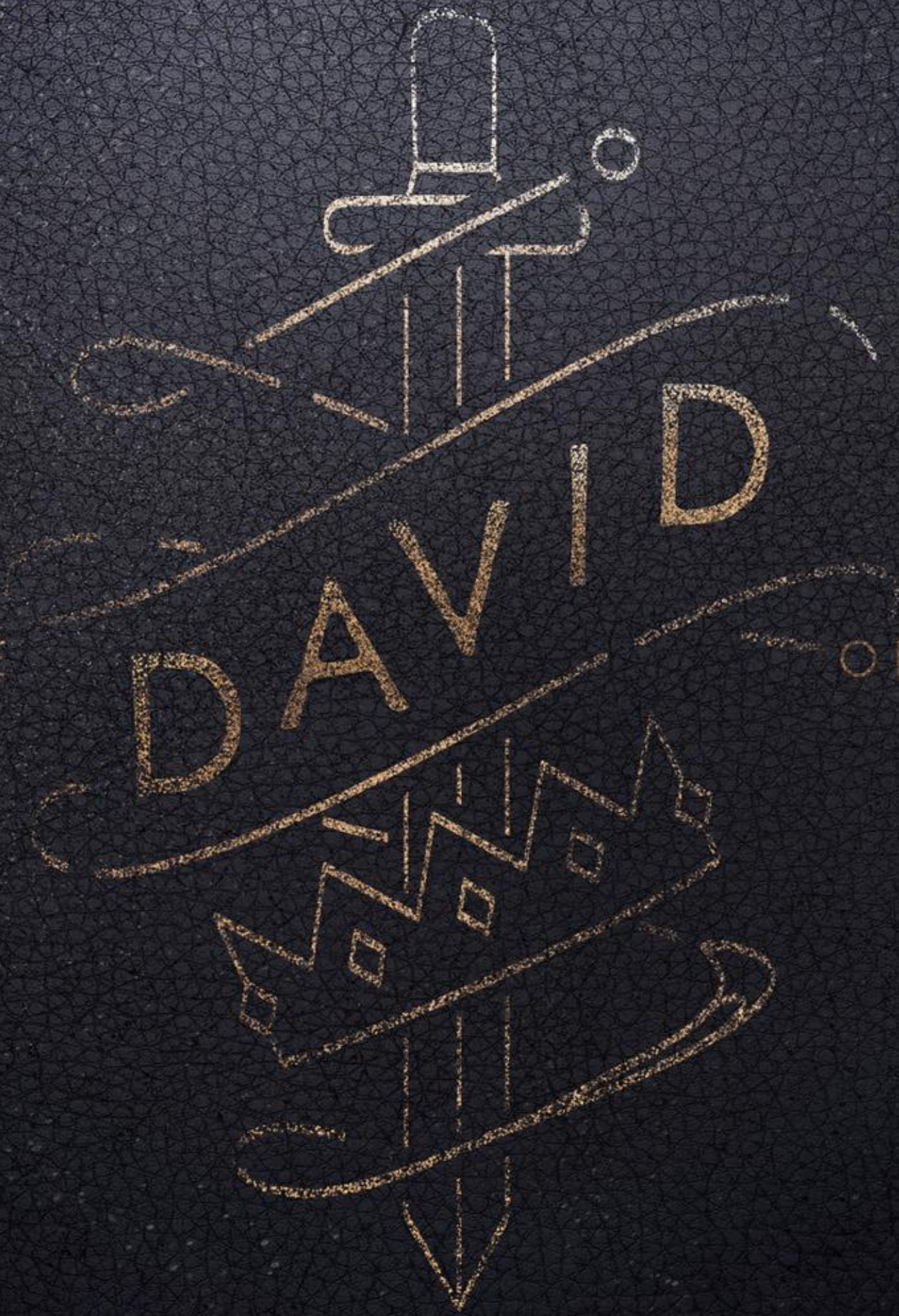
Even when it seems like it has:

FAIL**

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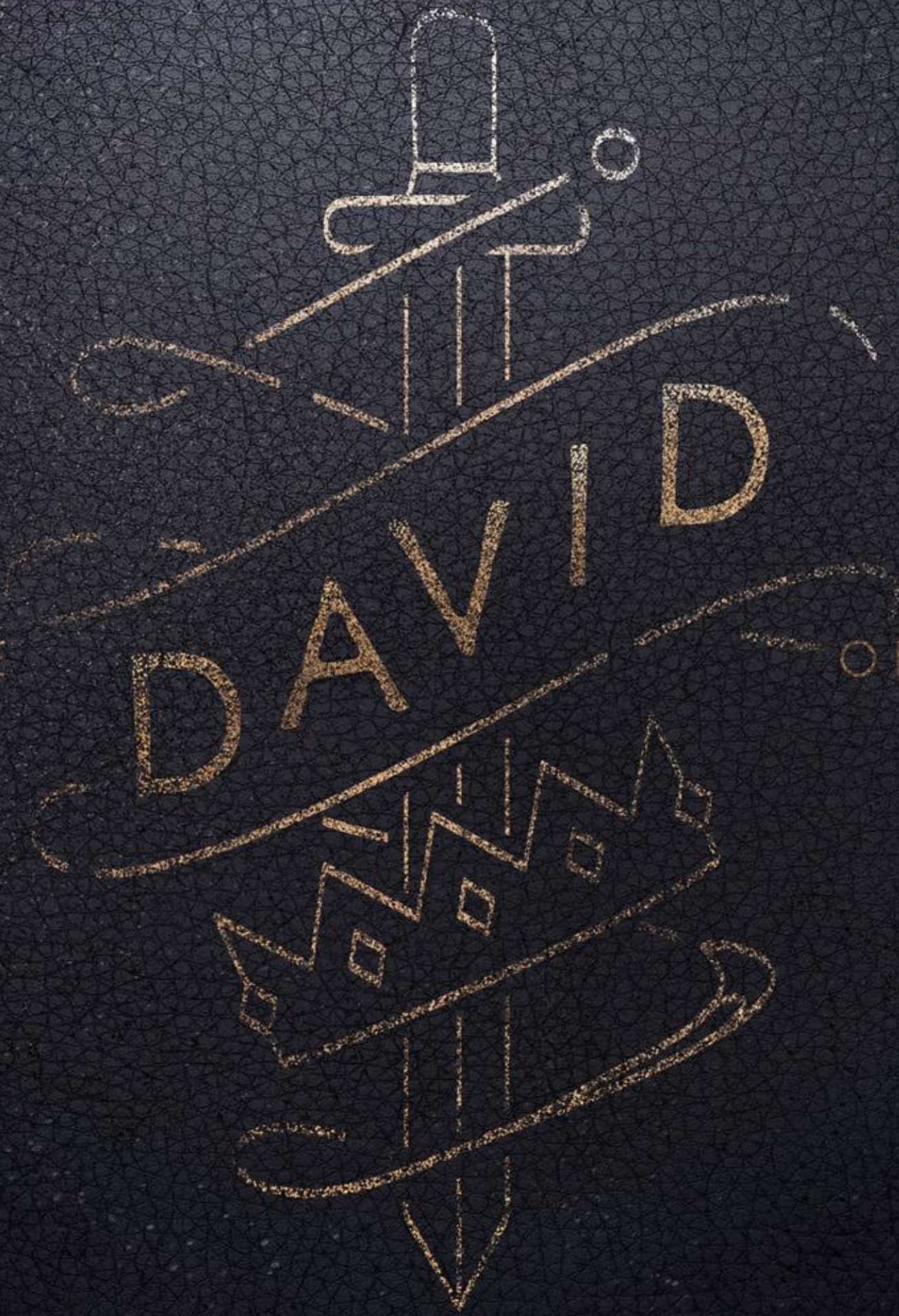
ISAIAH 11 : 1

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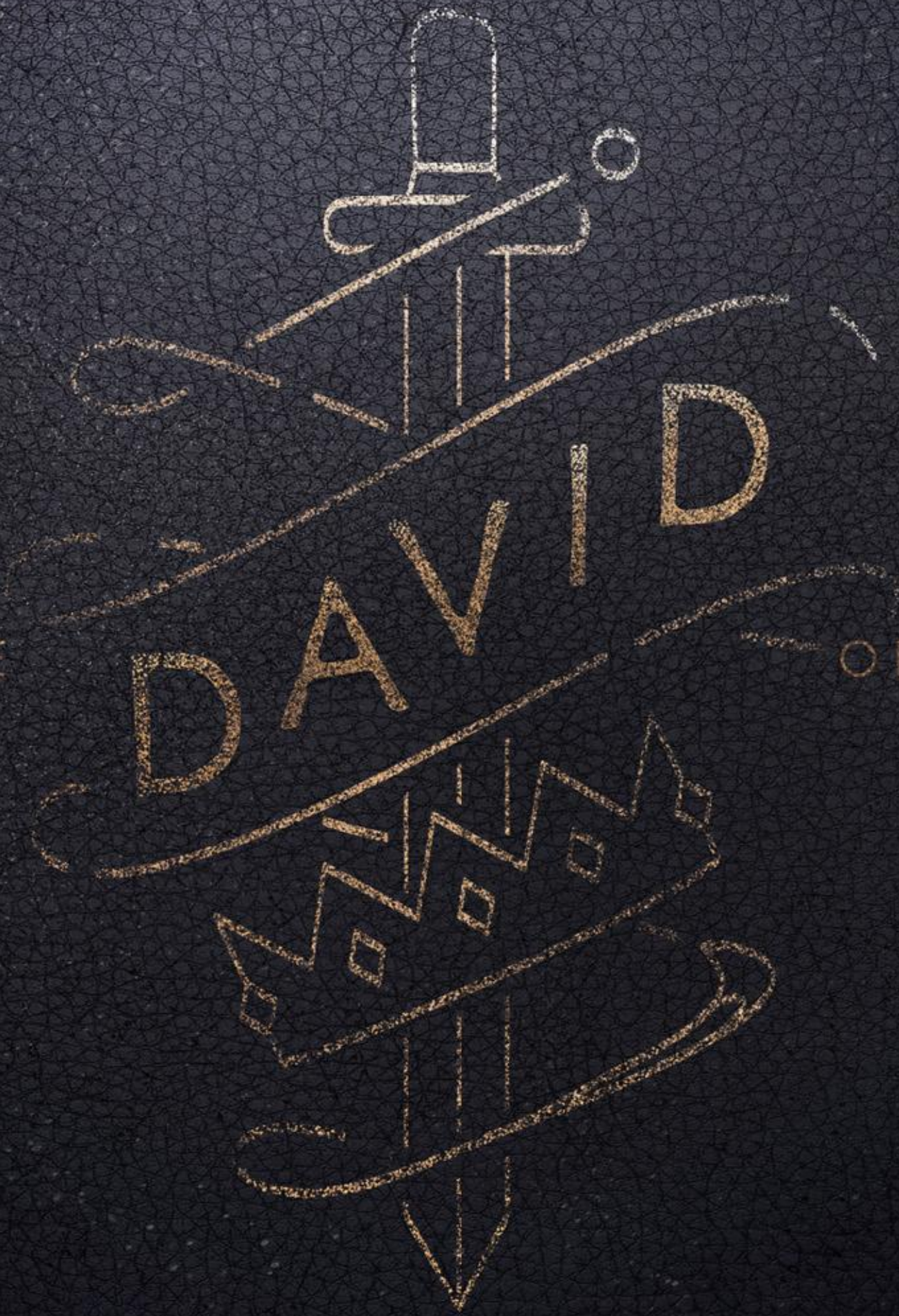
There has only ever been one who could fulfill this promise:

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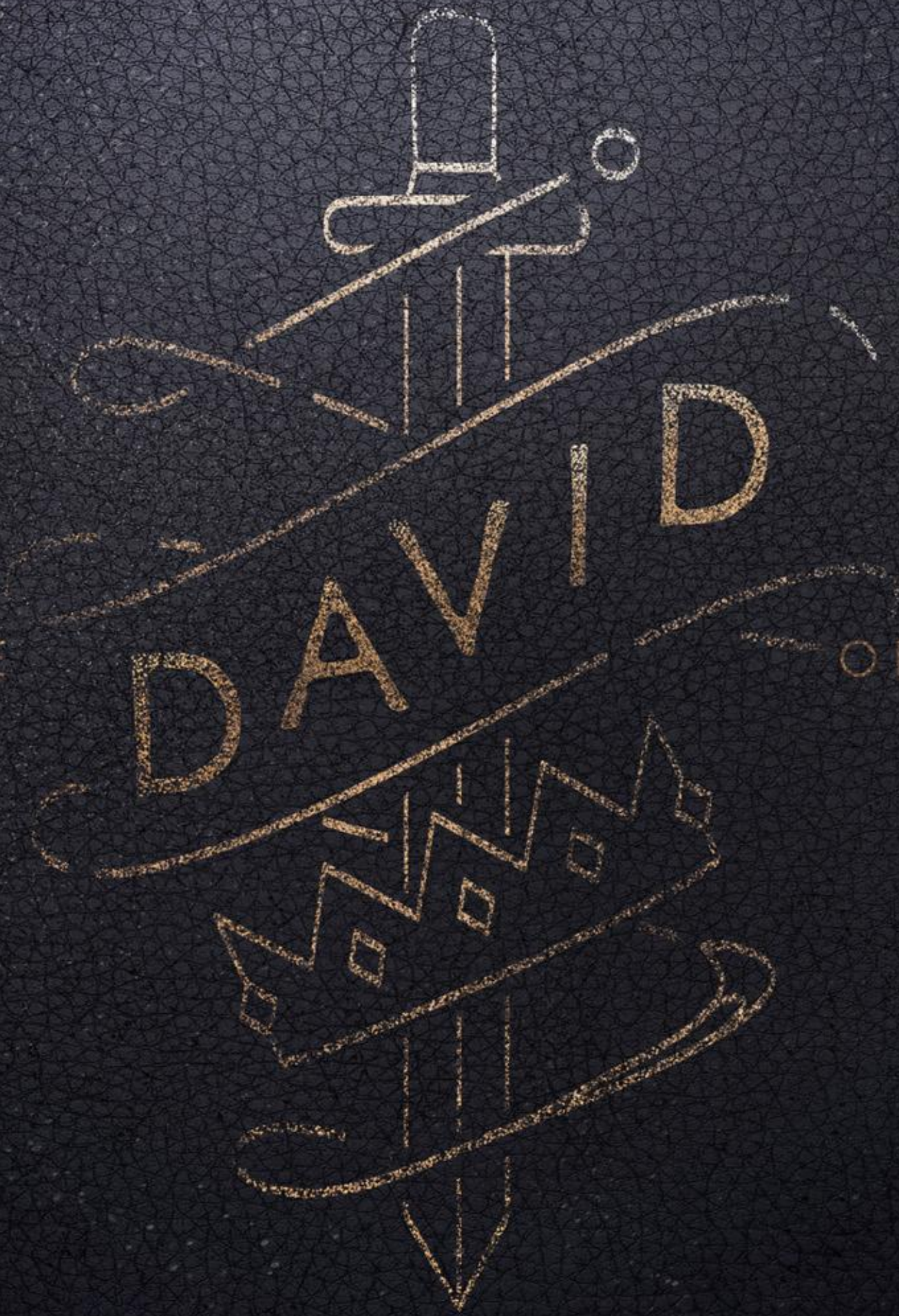
MATTHEW 1 : 1

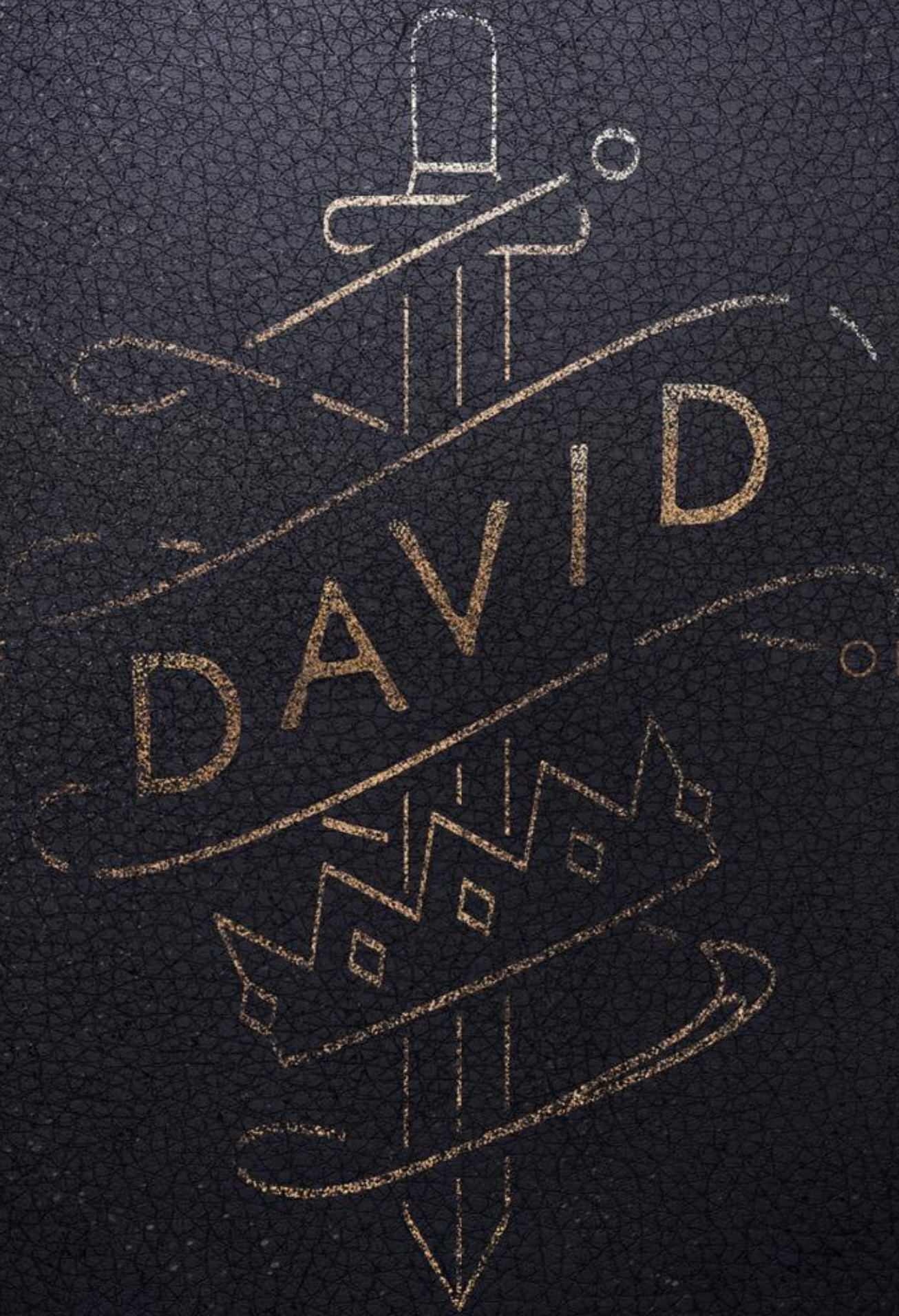
LUKE 1 : 31 – 33

David defeated his enemies on every side.

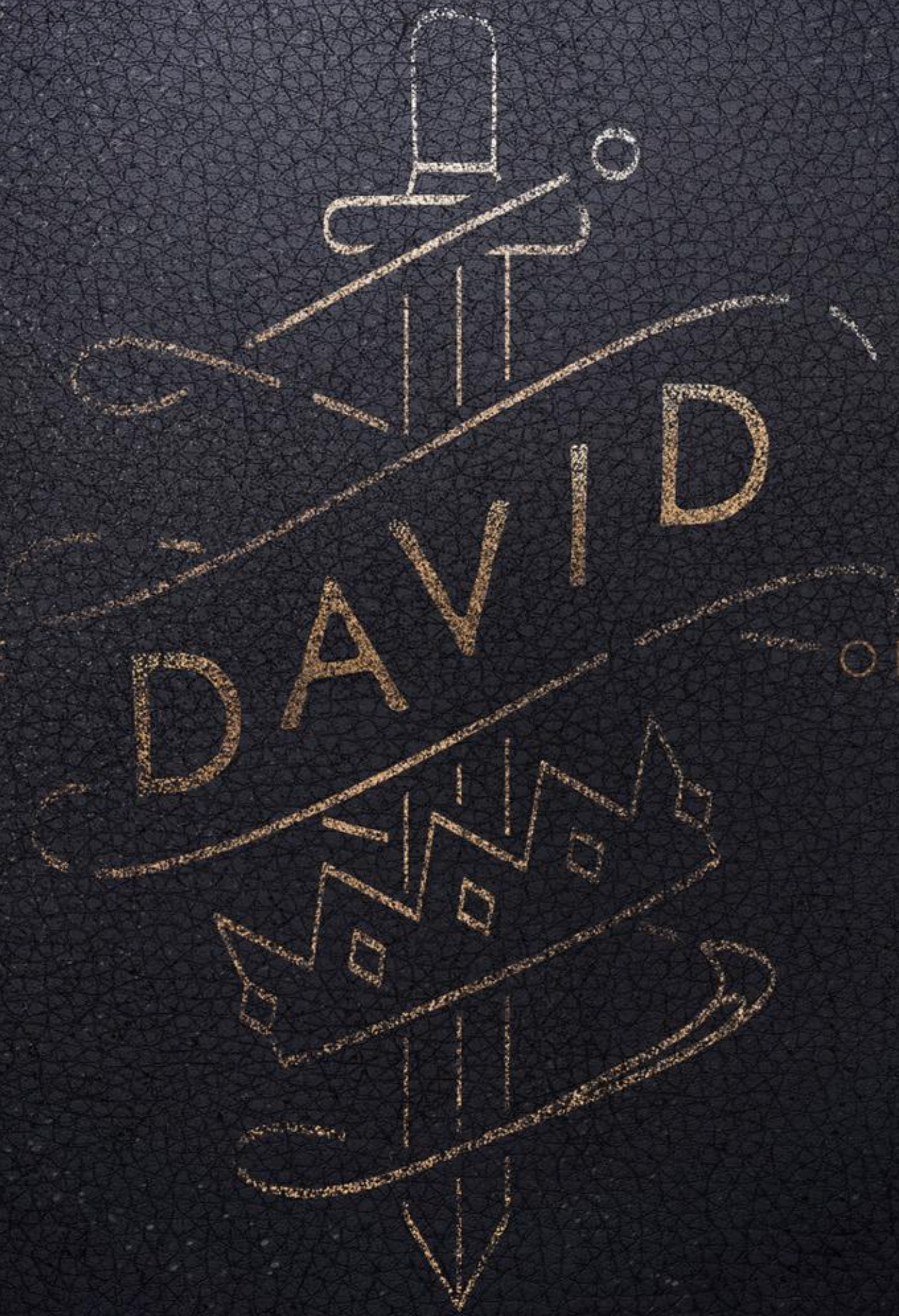
JESUS — 1 CORINTHIANS 15 : 54 – 57

MATTHEW 12 : 22 – 23

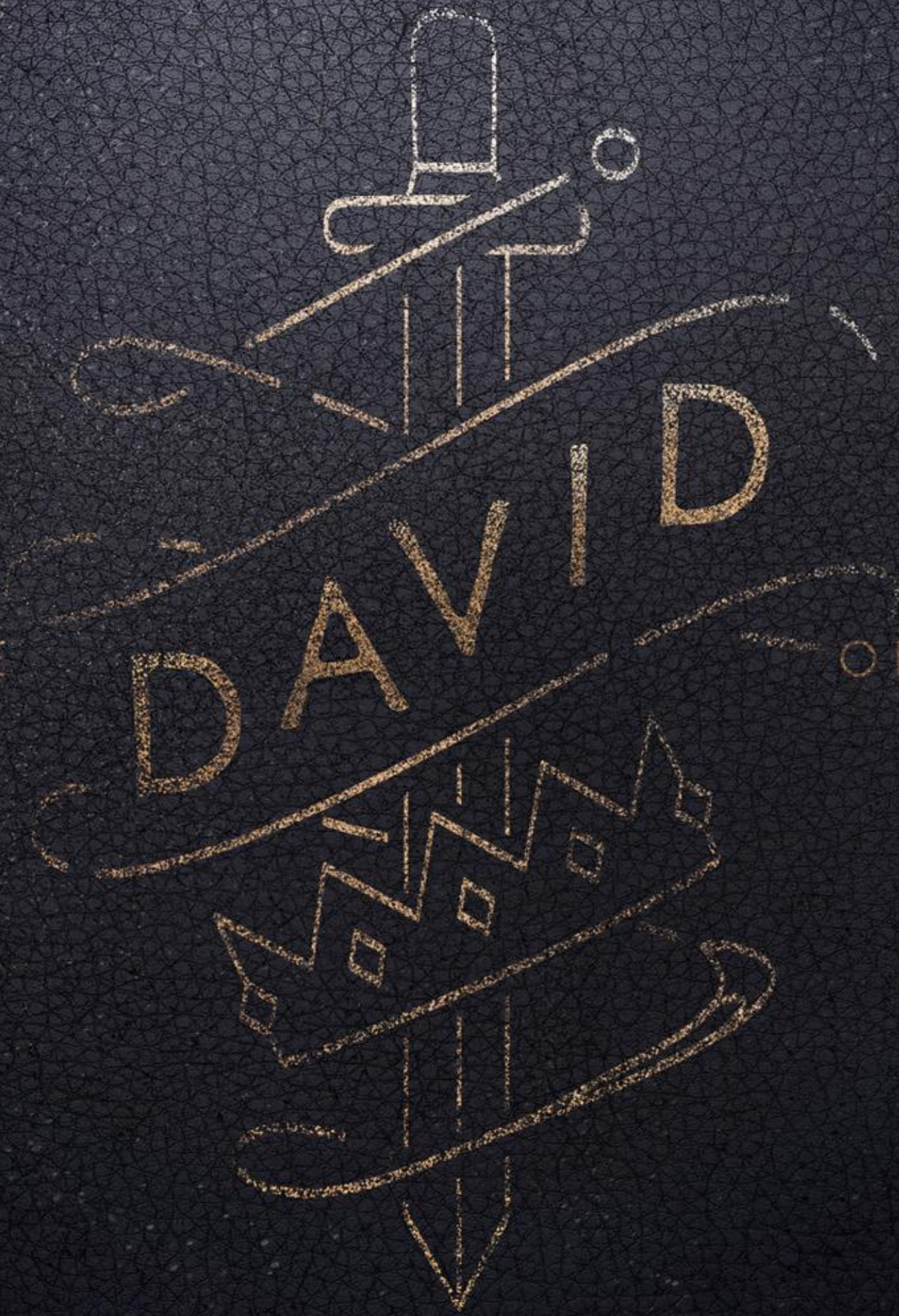

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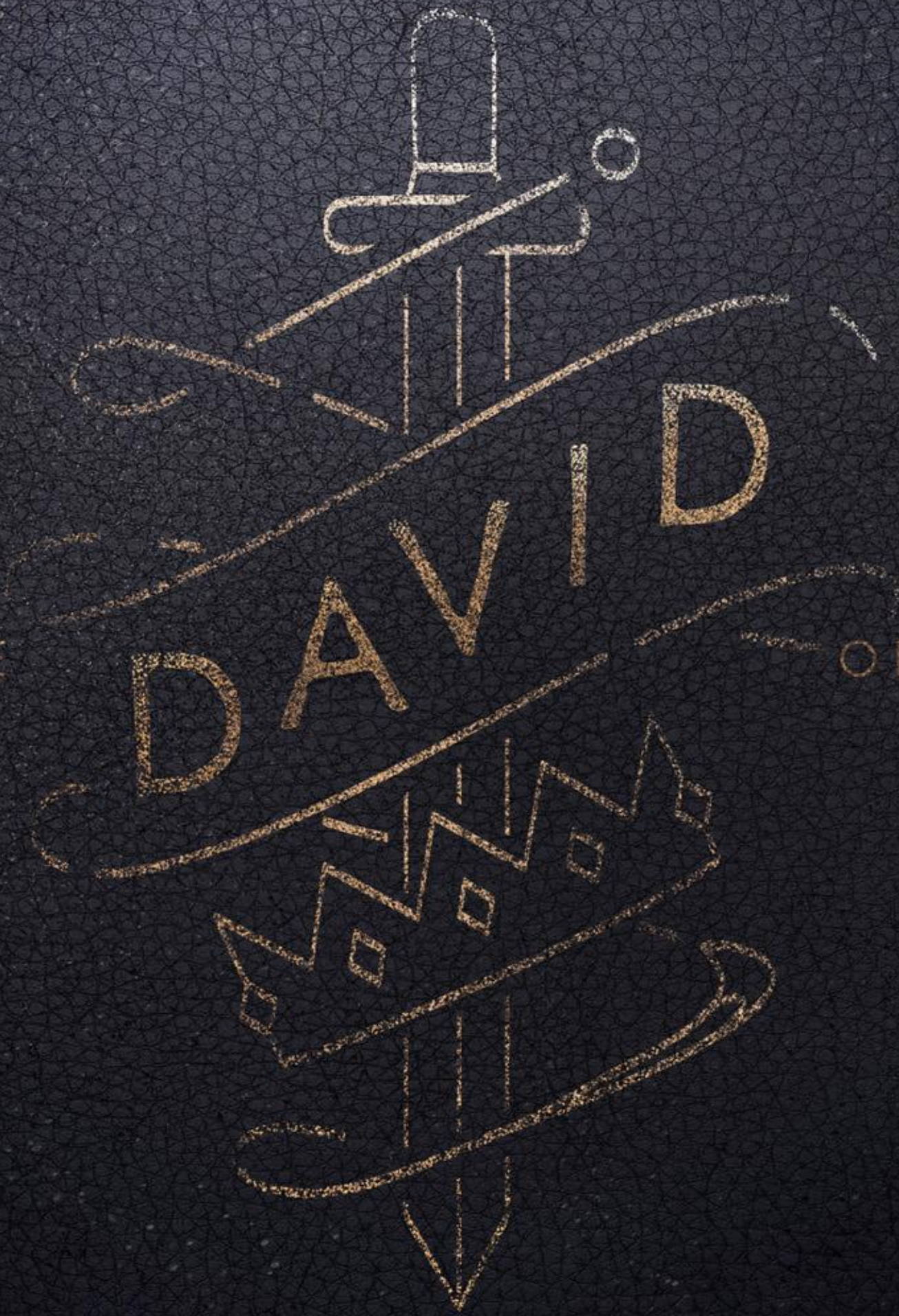
ROMANS 8 : 32
