






- · Original human language evolves from non-language

This data is entirely consistent with the Bible. *Genesis* 10–11 describes God's confusing of man's language at Babel, and the estimated number of language families is close to the same number of people groups that departed from Babel.

Enuma Elish

Enuma Elish - Although this account was found in Nineveh, the capital of the Assyrians, internal and external evidences both indicate that its origin dates back to the Sumerians. Most of it deals with the exploits of Marduk and his elevation to supremacy among the Babylonians gods, but it begins with the account of origins. "Specifically, Enuma Elish assumes that all things have evolved out of water. This description presents the earliest stage of the universe as one of watery chaos. The chaos consisted of three intermingled elements: Apse, who represents the sweet waters; Ti'amat, who represents the sea; and Mumnu, who cannot as yet be identified with certainty but may represent cloud banks and mist. These three types of water were mingled in a large undefined mass ...Then, in the midst of this watery chaos, two gods came into existence— Lahau and Lahamu.

Racism
