Pastor's Page

Summer is here! When I was growing up, that meant it was baseball season! My dad played Amateur Baseball for years, my older brother played up through Legion ball, and I played Little League for awhile. But we spent a lot of time at the ball field each and every summer. It has been fun seeing a few posts on Facebook of the start of a new baseball season this year.

I was remembering when our girls were little and they played T-ball in Summit. I always loved watching those youngest kids playing ball. They are not too concerned about winning but are just having a good time. You can see the joy on their faces when they hit the ball or catch it in their glove.

It was also fun to see how much they would improve over the course of a few week season. At the beginning of the summer, some of them didn't know which way to run after they hit the ball or how to get from 1st base to 2nd base. They would need a lot of coaching and directing. Even the ones who had played before, needed a little reminder. But by the end of the season, none of them needed any help at all. They had learned where to go and also learned the quickest way was to run straight at the base.

Our life of faith kind of parallels the life of T-Ball baseball player. When we begin to live out our faith, we are a little lost and need lots of direction. How do we do these things like worshipping, praying, reading the Bible, sharing our faith, and serving others? But with help, guidance, and practice our faith life grows, and we begin to learn how to live out our faith. It becomes easier to enter into prayer with God. We become familiar with how we worship and the meaning of what happens when we gather on Sunday morning. But it takes work, practice, coaching, and doing them on a regular basis.

This growing and learning in our faith is not something that only happens when we are young. We all need to continue to learn and study and practice these works of faith in our lives to grow closer to God and to deepen our faith. But it is especially important for our children to learn these faith practices when they are young. So that they can carry them with them as they grow into adults.

As parents, we are the number one coach in our children's faith lives. We model for them what a life of faith looks like. When we pray, come to worship, and serve others in God's name, our children see this and want to be like us. The church is here to support your work with things like Vacation Bible School, Sunday School, Take Out Church (read more about that inside this newsletter), but in the end it is up to the parents to pass on the faith to their children through the living of their own faith.

However, all of us play a role as coach and supporter for the youth of our congregation and for one another. In this family of faith, we are here to encourage each other on our faith journeys. To lift each other up when there is need and to celebrate when there are things to celebrate and to be a role model for one another.

So I encourage all of us to keep living the faith, keep carrying out these faith practices in our lives. Keep learning and growing in our faith so that we can be closer to God and to one another. I hope you celebrate the growth you have had in your faith and I pray that your faith may continue to be strengthened through worship, prayer, and Scripture.

Summer safety tips Looks like our long winter is over and now we are moving into summer. I want to share some safety tips.

- 1. Practice Summer Heat Safety. Never leave an infant or young child alone in a closed car in the summer. ...
- 2. Stay Safe Around Water. Never let a child near water unattended. ...
- 3. Protect Your Skin Against Sunburn. Use sunscreen with at least a 30 SPF or higher. A typical sunburn is the same as a first-degree burn. And if it blisters, that's a second-degree burn.
- 4. Keep the Bugs at Bay. I advise patients to spray themselves and their clothes with insect repellent containing DEET. ...
- 5. Avoid Poison Ivy. The stuff grows everywhere in the yard, beside the highway and in city parks. And if botany's not your thing, follow the old adage: "Leaves of three, let it be."
- 6. Stay hydrated.


American Lutheran SUNDAY SCHOOL
