If you have been out and about at all, you probably have noticed the red and pink heart decorations everywhere – in businesses, the schools, and even here at church! It is a sure sign that it is almost February and Valentine's Day is coming soon. That wonderful holiday celebrating love!

But did you know that Valentine's Day has its roots in Christianity. The Feast Day in the church is named after St. Valentine, an early Christian martyr who died for his faith. There isn't much known about him, except a beautiful story of him handing a heart-shaped note signed "your Valentine" to his jailer's daughter, who he had healed of her blindness.

From that story, Valentine's Day has evolved over the years into what we know of it today – a celebration of romantic love. And of course, anytime we talk about love and connect it to Scripture, we will think almost immediately of 1 Corinthians 13!

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails." 1 Corinthians 13:5-8a

These verses are read at the majority of weddings as two people are celebrating their love and joining their lives together as husband and wife. However, Paul did not write this passage specifically for weddings. His intention was to teach the people at the church in Corinth what true Christian love looked like. This list of what love is and what love is not is how we are to live our lives. Now, if you look at that list, it is pretty daunting.

Even on our best days and with those we love the most, I am afraid there will be times when we fail. When we get angry, or become rude. When we lose our patience or stop trusting those we love. But what Paul is encouraging us is to strive to love in this way. Strive to love the way Jesus loved in his life. Jesus showed kindness to lepers, patience with his disciples, humility by befriending prostitutes and thieves, and did not resent those who crucified him.

This is our goal as followers of Jesus Christ to take the love He has shown us and make it a part of our life. But then the question is, "To whom are we supposed to show this kind of love?" Our spouses, family, and friends, of course. But also our enemies – those people we disagree with, don't get along with at times, or just don't like. Jesus tells us to love our neighbors. To love all people, because all people are created by God.

I wish everyone a Happy Valentine's Day! Celebrate the romantic love that you have in your life. But also, take some time this month, to remember the Christian foundations of this holiday and celebrate the love God has for you. And strive to love the people in your life, with the love of 1 Corinthians 13.










Would you like to sponsor a Sunday Morning Radio Broadcast?


