Thank the Lord for His Deliverance

Psalm 107:1-32

This Psalm calls upon believers to give thanks to Yahweh for all aspects of His deliverance in our lives. Verse 1 tells us that the primary attribute of God for which we should be grateful is His lovingkindness. It is the New Testament equivalent of grace.

Verses 4-32 are divided into four sections representing four situations in which God demonstrates His lovingkindness and delivers His people from their troubles and for which we should be thankful.

You should thank the Lord...

1. When He guides you to restoration (v.4-9)

The Predicament: v.4-5

These verses describe the perilous situation that the Jews found themselves in when trying to return to their homeland.

The Plea: v.6a

That phrase *cried out* literally means "to shriek". Their cry for help was intense and emotional.

The Pardon: v.6b-7

The Lord led them by "providence" from the Latin "pro"- before, "video" – to see. God sees in advance

and provides what we need.

The Praise: v.8-9

2. When He liberates you from bondage.

3. When He heals you from affliction

4. When He rescues you from disaster.
