Scripture: John 4:4-18

Sermon Title: “Jesus Shares His Story”

First Thoughts

Few stories in the Bible are as relatable to us in 2026 as “The Samaritan Woman at the Well.”

A simple conversation with Jesus changed her entire outlook and life.

The Woman

The woman in John 4 certainly feels inadequate and “less than” in the presence of Jesus.

She is probably not a pure-blooded Jew, and her reputation is stained in Samaria.

Her low social status makes her an unlikely candidate to earn precious time with a rabbi.

She filled her life pursuing things that will not last and will not save her.

What have you filled your life with that is not growing you closer to God?

Jesus

The Son of God is physically tired when he meets the woman by the well.

Despite his fatigue, he sees an opportunity to share the Gospel with a marginalized woman.

On any given day, you never know who God may bring under your influence.

“Doing nothing” is not an option for Christians.

We are to be intentional in our dealings with non-believers.

The Message

Jesus promised the woman something called “Living Water.”

It would leave her satisfied and would never run out.

Only Jesus will satisfy the spiritual longings of this world.

Final Thoughts

This story teaches that no one is irredeemable or unforgiveable.

Are you praying that God will open doors for you to share the Gospel?

Will you pray that God will send someone to share the Gospel with your loved ones?
