SERMON TEXTS: ISAIAH 6:1-9, ROMANS 10:1-17

TEACHING & DIALOGUE

DISCOVER

Let's dig into the text together and discover what's happening in this passage.

Have someone read Isaiah 6:1-9 out loud.

- 1. Isaiah is given this vision from the Lord- the Lord is high and lifted up, on a throne and being worshipped. The train of His robe fills the entire temple. What is the imagery showing us about the Lord's nature? (He is the rightful King and Priest. Isaiah is filled with awe in this moment and with what He is seeing. We should have the same reaction when coming to the Lord.)
- 2. Upon seeing this vision, Isaiah becomes aware of his own sin. The Seraphim use a coal from the altar to make atonement. Why is this important? How does it change Isaiah and us? (Sin is not something the Lord takes lightly. For Isaiah to be used for his full calling, his sin had to be paid for so that he could walk in what the Lord had for him. The atonement he received changed the entire outcome of his life. It should do the same for us individually.)
- 3. When the Lord then asks, "Who will go for us?" Isaiah immediately responded with "Here I am! Send me." He had a radical heart change. Why do you think he was so eager to volunteer without knowing the full details? (He had seen the goodness of the Lord. He knew how miraculous it was to be in the Lord's presence.)
- 4. Do you find the same willingness to go where the Lord calls you? Or do you come up with

excuses not to go on the mission trip, or to serve in an area that stretches you? (Share as you feel led.)

DEEPEN

Now, let's dive deeper into God's Word and see how we might apply it to our lives.

Have someone read Romans 10:1-17 out loud. (Consider having multiple people read this passage)

- 1. Paul is talking to the Israelite people in this passage. He talks about how they were trying to establish their own righteousness, something as "church people", we can easily fall into. How can we focus on our relationship with God instead of trying to establish our own righteousness? (Remind ourselves of the gospel and what God did in rescuing us.)
- 2. Re-read verses 13-17 again. Paul stresses that people must hear the Word through someone preaching. Who did you first hear about Jesus from? If that person did not invite you to church, share the gospel or give you a Bible, would you know Jesus? (Share as you feel led. If you feel prompted, encourage people to reach out and thank that person if they can. It is rare we get to see the impact we have this side of heaven, and it may encourage that brother or sister to keep sharing.)

Sent Focus: This year, we will be introducing you each week to one or more of the long-term missionaries, church planters or missionary partners of which Eleven22 has a relationship. Our hope is that you will join us in praying for these folks as they seek to multiply the gospel to the ends of the earth!

Week 1: Pastor Blaine Boyd and family - Pastor Blaine has been the lead planting pastor of Redeemer Church of Al Ain in the United Arab Emirates. After helping that church grow, he and his family are currently working on another church plant in Kuwait City, Kuwait. He is part of the Acts29 Church Planting Network and Eleven22 is partnered with him and his family. Please join us in praying for them as they experience both hardships and miracles while pointing people to Jesus in difficult places.

ACTION STEP

As disciples of Jesus, we are sent. The question is, will we GO? This week, take ONE step towards Jesus and pray about where you will GO in 2020. Look at the discipleship journey tool and say, "Lord, yes I'll go. Now where are you sending me?"
