WHAT WILL BE THE SIGN?

- Then as He went out of the temple, one of His disciples said to Him, “Teacher, see what manner of stones and what buildings are here!” (Mark 13:1) And Jesus answered and said to him, “Do you see these great buildings? Not one stone shall be left upon another, that shall not be thrown down.” (Mark 13:2)
- Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives opposite the temple, Peter, James, John, and Andrew asked Him privately, (Mark 13:3) “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign when all these things will be fulfilled?” (Mark 13:4) And Jesus, answering them, began to say: “Take heed that no one deceives you. (Mark 13:5) “For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am He,’ and will deceive many. (Mark 13:6)

WAR, FAMINES, ETC. ARE THE BEGINNING

- “But when you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be troubled; for such things must happen, but the end is not yet. (Mark 13:7) “For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be earthquakes in various places, and there will be famines and troubles. These are the beginnings of sorrows. (Mark 13:8)
- “But watch out for yourselves, for they will deliver you up to councils, and you will be beaten in the synagogues. You will be brought before rulers and kings for My sake, for a testimony to them. (Mark 13:9) “And the gospel must first be preached to all the nations. (Mark 13:10)

DON'T WORRY WHEN TAKEN BEFORE RULERS

- “But when they arrest you and deliver you up, do not worry beforehand, or premeditate what you will speak. But whatever is given you in that hour, speak that; for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit. (Mark 13:11)
- And they laid hands on them, and put them in custody until the next day, for it was already evening. (Acts 4:3) on the next day... their rulers, elders, and scribes, (Acts 4:5) as well as Annas the high priest, Caiaphas, John, and Alexander, and as many as were of the family of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem. (Acts 4:6) Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, “Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: (Acts 4:8)

HE WHO ENDURES TO THE END SHALL BE SAVED

- “Now brother will betray brother to death, and a father his child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death. (Mark 13:12) “And you will be hated by all for My name’s sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved. (Mark 13:13)
- Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution. (2Tim 3:12)
- they stoned Paul and dragged him out of the city, supposing him to be dead. (Acts 14:19) However, when the disciples gathered around him, he rose up and went into the city... (Acts 14:20) strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting them to continue in the faith, and saying, “We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.” (Acts 14:22)

THE ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION

- “So when you see the ‘abomination of desolation,’ spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not” (let the reader understand), “then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. (Mark 13:14) “Let him who is on the housetop not go down into the house, nor enter to take anything out of his house. (Mark 13:15) “And let him who is in the field not go back to get his clothes. (Mark 13:16) “But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! (Mark 13:17) “And pray that your flight may not be in winter. (Mark 13:18)
- “And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up... (Dan 12:11)

WHEN WILL THEY WELCOME YESHUA? IN TRIBULATION.

- “For in those days there will be tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the creation which God created until this time, nor ever shall be. (Mark 13:19) “And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh would be saved; but for [δια δε τους] the elect’s sake, whom He chose, He shortened the days. (Mark 13:20) *Dia + accusative: the reason why someth. happens, results, exists: because of, (BDAG) i.e. as a result of the elect, the days are shortened.*
- “for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say, "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!" (Matt 23:39)
- For I will be like a lion to Ephraim, And...to the house of Judah. I, even I, will tear them and go away... (Hos 5:14) I will return again to My place Till they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My face; In their affliction [tribulation צרה], they will earnestly seek Me.” (Hos 5:15)
- Alas! For that day is great...the time of Jacob's trouble [tribulation צרה], But he shall be saved out of it. (Jer 30:7)
- “I will pour out on the kingship of David and the population of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and supplication so that they will look to [el אל] me, the one they have pierced. They will lament for him as one laments for an only son... (Zech 12:10 [NET2])

BEWARE OF FALSE CHRISTS

- “Then if anyone says to you, ‘Look, here is the Christ!’ or, ‘Look, He is there!’ do not believe it. (Mark 13:21) “For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. (Mark 13:22) “But take heed; see, I have told you all things beforehand. (Mark 13:23)

THE DARKENING OF SUN & MOON

- “But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; (Mark 13:24) And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. (Rev 9:2)
- For the stars of heaven and their constellations Will not give their light; The sun will be darkened in its going forth, And the moon will not cause its light to shine. (Isaiah 13:9, 10)
- ...his kingdom became full of darkness; (Rev 16:10)


STARS/FALLEN ANGELS DEFEATED

- “the stars of heaven will fall, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. (Mark 13:25)
- “The seven stars are the angels...” (Rev 1:20)
- “...it cast down *some* of the host [of heaven] and *some* of the stars to the ground, and trampled them. (Dan 8:10)
- All the host of heaven [fallen angels] shall be dissolved....All their host shall fall down...as fruit falling from a fig tree. (Isaiah 34:4 & Rev 6:13)
- And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit. And he opened the bottomless pit,. **Rev 9:1-2**
- His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth...**Rev 12:4** So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. **Rev 12:9 NKJV**

THE VEIL BETWEEN THE DOMAINS

- “Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. (Mark 13:26)
- “...Jesus came up...the heavens were opened to Him...” (Matt 3:16)
- Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. (Matt 24:35)
- “I see the heavens opened ...” (Acts 7:56)
- “...the sky receded as a scroll when it is rolled up...” (Rev 6:14)
- “...I saw heaven opened...” (Rev 19:11)

- “He will destroy on this mountain the surface of the covering cast over all people, And the veil that is spread over all nations...” (Isa 25:7)
- **the heavens will pass away** with a great noise... 2Pet 3:10)
- “...the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll...” (Isa 34:4)
- “oh that you would rend the heavens and come down.” (Isa 64:1)

REBUKE AND FLAMES OF FIRE

- “Then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with **great power and glory**. (Mark 13:26)
- behold, *One* like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days... (Dan 7:13)
- For behold, **the LORD comes out of His place** To punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity...(Isa 26:21)
- Then the **LORD will go forth and fight against those nations**, As He fights in the day of battle. (Zech 14:3)
- when the Lord Jesus is **revealed** from heaven with His mighty angels, in **flaming fire** taking **vengeance**... (2Thess 1:7-8)
- For behold, the LORD will come with **fire** And with His chariots, like a whirlwind, To render His **anger** with fury, And His **rebuke** with **flames of fire**. For by fire and by His sword The LORD will judge all flesh; And the slain of the LORD shall be many. (Isa 66:15-16)

DAY OF THE LORD: EARTH DEVASTATED

- “the LORD of hosts musters the army for battle...The LORD and His weapons of **indignation** [דַּוָּר za'am], To destroy the whole land.” “Behold, the **day of the LORD**... to lay the land desolate; I will **shake the heavens**, And the **earth will move out of her place**, In the wrath of the LORD of hosts And **in the day** of His fierce anger. (Isa 13:4-9, 13)
- The **earth is violently broken**, The **earth is split open**, The earth is **shaken exceedingly**. The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, And shall totter like a hut; Its transgression shall be heavy upon it, **And it will fall, and not rise again**. (Isa 24:19-20)
- And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great **earthquake**, such a mighty and **great earthquake** as had not occurred since men were on the earth... (Rev 16:18) **...every island fled away**, and the **mountains were not found**. (Rev 16:20)



THE MIGHTY HIDE IN CAVES

- They shall go into the **holes of the rocks**, And into the **caves** of the earth, From the **terror of the LORD** And the glory of His majesty, **When He arises to shake the earth mightily**,” (Isa 2:19 and verse 21)
- “And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the **caves and in the rocks** of the mountains,” and said to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us and **hide us** from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the **wrath** of the Lamb! “For the **great day of His wrath has come**, and who is able to stand?” (Rev 6:14-17)

THE GREAT TRUMPET & GATHERING

- “And then He will send His angels, and gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest part of earth to the farthest part of heaven. (Mark 13:27)
- **Son of Man coming on the clouds** of heaven with power and great glory. And He will send His angels with a **great sound of a trumpet**,* and they will **gather** together His elect... (Matt 24:30-31) - * [...a **loud voice**, as of a **trumpet**, I am the **Alpha and Omega**...(Rev 1:10)]
- The **LORD also will roar from Zion**, And utter His voice from **Jerusalem**; The heavens and earth will shake; But the LORD will be a shelter for His people., (Joel 3:16)
- ...The great **trumpet** will be blown; They will come... (Isa 27:13)
- For the **Lord Himself will descend from heaven** with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the **trumpet** of God. And the **dead in Christ will rise first**. (I Thess 4:14-16)

THE FIG TREE (YESHUA COMES AFTER A LONG TIME)

- “Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender, and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. (Mark 13:28) “So you also, when you see these things happening, know that it is near—at the doors! (Mark 13:29) “Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place. (Mark 13:30)
- “Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away. (Mark 13:31) “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. (Mark 13:32) “Take heed, watch and pray; for you do not know when the time is. (Mark 13:33) “It is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each his work, and commanded the doorkeeper to watch. (Mark 13:34) “Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming—in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning— (Mark 13:35) “lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping. (Mark 13:36) “And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!” (Mark 13:37)
