# Epiphany

**All people who are in Christ, regardless of social, ethnic, or economic background, are adopted into the Kingdom through the New Covenant. This is what Epiphany celebrates.**

Consider the Old Covenant and the ethnic limitations it allowed for. How does the New Covenant express the Kingdom of God more fully?

How is the New Covenant a "better" covenant? What are the comparisons to the Old Covenant that reveal God's glory more fully?

**Consider the 10 Commandments. How many would you confidently say you've never broken? How would you feel if we listed all 613 Old Covenant commands to see how well you've done?**

Consider Hebrews 8. What are 5 points that are taught in our sermon that reveal New Covenant characteristics?

How are non-Jews considered descendants of Abraham in the Galatian teachings? Why is this good news for us?
