Luke 24:50-53

The ascension of Jesus marks the completion of His incarnate work on earth. It's in this moment that Jesus returns to glory by rising up into heaven.

While reflecting on all that we've observed through the life of Jesus, does the text of the ascension bring a spiritual satisfaction at the complete work of Jesus' earthly ministry?

Another miraculous event takes place in front of the disciples, except this time their response is to worship. Do you see how a better understanding of Scripture results in a better response to Jesus?

GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

Ephesians 1:20-23 tell us where Jesus went: that he (God) worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all.

The ascension put Jesus in heaven next to the Father where He now intercedes on our behalf. And He sent the Holy Spirit to replace Him on earth to minister to us!

Jesus is alive forevermore! Celebrate that truth today.
