However the early endurance we all had seems to have now given away into a deep weariness. We all look forward to the holidays and the new year, searching for some hope. But new restrictions are coming, and we have to ask if anything about this year can be redeemed.

The book of Ruth is an indication to us that Redemption is very possible! Ruth is a real story of setbacks, loss and redemption.

So here we are in chapter 4 and we are on the verge of 2 marvelous redemptions, the climax appears to be right over the corner and we await, holding our breath:

- 1. The first is a Legal Redemption:** in Ruth 4:1-12
- 2. The second is a Relational Redemption:** in Ruth 4:13-22
