Today we get to take a look at Jesus in the most corrupt trial in history. Jesus is put on trial by people who are corrupt and will convict the only innocent man there. But where men fail to do the right thing God prevails in bringing righteousness to all who would believe! We will look into how Jesus fulfills the roles that men failed at, and why all people everywhere need Jesus!
