1st Corinthians 7:1-7

Paul gives instructions regarding sexual morality inside of marriage. Celibacy OUTSIDE of marriage is required, celibacy INSIDE of marriage is forbidden. The text today explains.

Have you ever seen an example of an overcorrection from somebody when it comes to religious morality? How have the Corinthians demonstrated that regarding sexual morality?

When you read Scripture that directly contradicts a popular secular worldview, what is your initial reaction? When Paul says that the body of a husband or wife does not belong to them but to their spouse, how is that contrary to secularism? How do you feel about that instruction?

Paul teaches that celibacy in marriage is forbidden. What are reasons that celibacy in marriage may be harmful? Why is a healthy sex life in marriage helpful?

Paul teaches that celibacy outside of marriage is required. Why can remaining single be helpful in ministry?

Chapter 6 showed us why sexual immorality impacts us in wholistically unhealthy ways. Chapter 7 shows us that sexual morality inside of marriage impacts us in wholistically healthy ways. Do you see the contrast?
