Acts 18:1-17

Suffering, weakness, and fear has been experienced by all people in the Christian walk, even the great men and women of faith. Today's text will show us what brought Paul encouragement as he walked in suffering, weakness, and fear.

3 things that brought Paul encouragement in Corinth:

1. Christian Friendships
 - 1-5
2. Converts
 - 6-8
3. The Presence of God
 - 9-11
