Philippians 2:5-8

Paul drives home his point of unity and humility by pointing us to the person who is the ultimate model of humility – Jesus Christ.
In these passages, we see how understanding the value of Christ's character will aid us in transforming our character, leading us to be a people who walk in humility and unity.

Paul gives 8 examples of the descent of Jesus. Can you list them in order as we study them?

Of these examples, were any more challenging to listen to/learn about than others? Were any more challenging to personally apply as an example to follow?

We all have a flesh nature that rages against living humbly. We live in a world where pride is exalted and overshadows humility, leading to division, conflict, and a lack of empathy.

Have you ever looked to Jesus as the ultimate model of humility? Do you see Him as your source of strength as you strive to live a life of humility?

As you reflect on the text, ask yourself the following: Is this my attitude, my mindset? Is this my way of life? Do I seek to get or to give? Do I strive to think of others more highly than myself?

Is this our mindset as a community? Are we known for humility and compassion? A church that thinks of others more highly than themselves? Is Christ's life lived out in our lives and our church?
