Acts 27:1-44

The narrative of Paul's shipwreck is a powerful example of the sovereign work of God. His power is on display and His grace is evident throughout the chapter.

A few truths from the text:

- 1. The Bible is Scientifically and Historically Accurate
- What example do we see in the authenticity of the narrative?
- Can you think of other examples from Scripture that science and history confirm later?
- Do you value the apologetic approach to Scripture confirmation? Is it needed?
- 2. Money Makes us do Dumb Things
- Has the pursuit of more "treasure" caused you to make terrible decisions?
- How have you been able to properly place the value of treasure under the value of Christ?
- 3. Paul Had the Aid of Faithful Companions
- Luke and Aristarchus are present on the journey. What does this say about them?
- What does this say about Paul? Why are godly companions so valuable? Who are your closest gospel-minded friends?
- 4. God is Still in Control
- List the aspects of the story that God isn't in control of.
- How could we predict the ending of the chapter?
