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1st Corinthians 1:26-2:5

The wisdom of God is a paradox to the wisdom of man. Paul spends this section reminding us of how the gift of new life is given to the humble.

The power of the gospel doesn't need a celebrity endorsement as it has the power to save on it's own. How does this help our evangelistic endeavors?

What are the four gifts of our salvation that Paul mentions in verse 30?

Do you recognize that none of those can be earned or developed on our own? How can pride harm our growth in these areas?

How is the wisdom of God given to us in the past, present, and future? Explain how that may look in your life.

Which Scriptures are mentioned referencing boasting in the Lord? How do you boast in the Lord? Who have you boasted in the Lord to?

Paul says in multiple letters things like "preach the Word" and "I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified." Why is the gospel message the most important message to share? How does the gospel message change people differently than simply feeding their bellies?
