Luke 24:13-32

The most important reality that exists in our world today is the truth of the Word of God. Jesus' walk to Emmaus reminds us of that.

Have you ever heard the Bible taught but didn't understand it? Has the truth of Scripture ever been revealed to you in a way that brought understanding?

The Word of God is power. It's one thing to <u>hear</u> the Word, another thing to <u>believe</u> the Word, and another thing to <u>understand</u> the Word.

The two disciples in our text heard the teachings of Jesus and knew the teachings of the Old Testament. Yet they seemingly didn't understand, and eventually didn't believe, His teaching concerning the suffering and resurrection.
