Luke 23:13-25

The idea of justice from a human perspective is turned upside down by the idea of justice from a Kingdom perspective. The innocent Lamb is declared guilty so the guilty sheep can be declared innocent.

Our commentator breaks our text down in 5 categories:

1. Adjudication
 - The sentence rendered by the judge
 - Luke 23:13-15
2. Accommodation
 - Doing a kindness or a favor
 - Luke 23:16
3. Alternative
 - A choice limited to one of two or more possibilities
 - Luke 23:17-19
4. Assertion
 - A declaration, often without support or reason
 - Luke 23:20-23
5. Acquiescence
 - Agreement or consent by silence or without objection
 - Luke 23:24-25

Consider Jesus' innocence and the declaration of guilt. Now consider our sin guilt and the declaration of innocence at salvation. Give praise to our Substitute!
