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1st Corinthians 12:1-3

A majority of reasons that a church is divided is rooted in pride. The Corinthian church experienced the same divisions, and this included the way they abused spiritual gifting. Paul addresses this in this section of Scripture.

What do you believe the point of spiritual gifting is?

As you examine the history of the Corinthian church so far in the letter, do you see how easy it is for the church to be divided on the expression of the gifts?

Do you understand that the purpose of the gifts is to edify the church and point people to Christ? How is the latter shown in the text? Why do you believe it’s valuable for Paul to begin this section with that reminder?

Hearing the history of the Corinthian culture and their pagan practices, why do you think it’s so important for Paul to distinguish what spiritual gifting IS and what it IS NOT?

As we get into this section, is there a particular element that you are most looking forward to learning about? Share with your group leader or one of our elders for further dialogue.
