Acts 19:1-20

The Holy Spirit has had His fingerprints all over the movement of the New Testament Church. His presence is experienced in Acts 19 as Paul returns to minister in Ephesus.

Do you understand the difference between water baptism and the baptism of the Holy Spirit? Baptism of the Holy Spirit happens AT salvation, water baptism happens BECAUSE OF salvation.

Paul meets 12 disciples of John the Baptist who haven't been baptized in the Holy Spirit. Why is this necessary? Why is this an indication that they aren't yet followers of Jesus?

Paul teaches the Kingdom to those in Ephesus. As RC Sproul puts it: To teach the Kingdom is to teach all things concerning Jesus and salvation, all things concerning righteousness, to teach how to enter the sphere of salvation and live there in communion with God.

Do you see how it's important, just as with Apollos last week, that a whole view of the person of Jesus is necessary for followership of Christ?

The Spirit of God begins to use extraordinary measures to verify the message of Jesus in Paul's ministry. Do you see how some examples of the way the Spirit works in Scripture may be more descriptive of how He did ministry and less prescriptive of how it'll always be done? \bigcirc
