1st Corinthians 10:14-22

We are created to worship. We will either worship God or His created things, and Paul warns against the danger of idolatry in our text today.

Have you ever considered how idolatry is found in ordinary daily experiences? Can you identify idols that you've set up in your heart?

Idols aren't usually things that you've replaced the Lord with, but things that you've added to the throne of your heart next to the Lord. Have you found it easy to add things to your worship IN ADDITION TO Christ?

In considering what your idols may be, ask yourself these questions:

- What motivates you to go to work? (Or avoid working?)
- What causes you to eat the way that you do?
- What desires are in your heart that affect the way you relate to your spouse?
- What do you daydream/fantasize/long for?
- What's the end goal of your life?

Idols are created in the ordinary rhythms of life. But Christ meets us in the ordinary rhythms of life!

Does this reminder help you find freedom in the victory that we've been given over sin?
