# Life of Elisha 2nd Kings 3:11-20

In faith we act knowing the promises of God must be true and will be fulfilled. Elisha instructed the kings to act in faith for the preparation of receiving a blessing. But the ditches had to be dug so the water could be held.

Have you ever been given a blessing that you didn't expect? Have you ever been given a blessing that you weren't prepared to receive?

We believe God to pour His blessings on us but aren't always looking for it. We sometimes miss it or haven't prepared ourselves for them.

What are some ways you can "prepare" to receive a blessing?

God didn't send the water because they dug ditches, they simply dug ditches to be able to utilize the water that God sent. Do you see the difference between "earning" a blessing from God and "preparing to receive" a blessing from God?

Jehoshaphet was a godly king but waited until his back was against the wall before seeking God. Do you see the danger in waiting until you're desperate to seek God? Do you see the wisdom in seeking God's counsel before your venture?
