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1st Corinthians 12:4-7

Spiritual Gifts are created, distributed, and empowered by the triune Godhead. The Father, the Son, and the Spirit all play a part in equipping and empowering the saints to do a supernatural work in the church.

Paul's concern with the church isn't that it's not uniform, but that it's not united. How do spiritual gifts unite a church? Does a diversity of gifts help with unity? How?

Has anybody ever identified what your spiritual gifting is? If so, what is it and how is it being used?

If the Holy Spirit activates (energizes) your gifts, what role do you play in using them? How can you pursue the gifts and the use of them?

Have you ever been tempted to compare your gifting to the gifting of others? Is it helpful to know that all gifting is equal in the eyes of God?

The results of a church that is Spirit-filled and walking in step with the Holy Spirit in gifting is:

1. The church family is blessed and edified
2. The witness of the church becomes effective and dynamic
3. The church grows in joy, unity, love, and fellowship
