Philippians 3:4-11

The resurrection of Jesus changes us! And it changes the way we understand where our confidence comes from. If we gain Christ but lose everything else then we've come out ahead!

Consider the confidence that you've had in your flesh regarding religious right-standing with God. How have you been tempted to believe in a self-righteous understanding of salvation? How do you best understand it now?

Paul gives an account of what his pre-conversion "GAINS" column looked like. Can you list them from Philippians 3:4-6?

Consider your religious accomplishments. How would you list your "GAINS" column if you had confidence in the flesh?

Does your confidence in Christ allow you to see how all of those should be considered "LOSSES"?

Knowing that your own righteousness doesn't bring you into right-standing with God, how does this free you up to simply delight in Christ?
