Acts 25:1-12

Sin holds us captive as we become enslaved to the desires of the flesh. It's the gospel of Jesus that frees us from the bondage of sin. The gripping power of sin is found in our text today.

A few thoughts concerning our text:

1. The Greatest Enemy of Christianity is False Religion

- What type of people persecuted Jesus, Paul, and the early church?
- How is this on display in today's culture?
- Read John 15:18-25. How is this shown today?

2. Sin Enslaves You

- Read John 8:34 and 2nd Peter 2:19. Have you seen this in your life?
- What sins have you been enslaved to? How have they manifested themselves?
- Are there sins that you've been delivered from?
 Share that testimony.

3. We see at Work the Sovereignty of God in Acts 25

- Consider the story of Joseph in Genesis. How is God's sovereignty shown in Genesis 45:7-8?
- Do you see how God is at work in all human relations? How is He at work in yours?
- How is He at work in Acts 25?

4. Paul Demonstrates the Proper Relation to

Government

- Read Romans 13:1-5. How does this play out today?
- Why is this challenging for believers today?
