Acts 17:16-34

Mankind has always struggled to understand and believe absolute truth. Paul faces several schools of philosophy when he arrives in Athens, philosophies that identify our culture today. And they run in direct contradiction to the gospel.

What philosophies would you say mark our post-modern society? How do they compare to the great philosophers of old?

Paul makes three primary points to those listening in Athens

- You Need to Recognize that there is a God
- You Need to Recognize Who God Is
- You Need to Recognize What God Said

Do you believe there is a God? Do you recognize who God is? Do you submit to what He has said in His Word and through His Spirit?

Paul teaches that ignorance is no longer an excuse. It's not an excuse for rejecting Christ or for sinful living for Christ has been revealed to us!

Paul gives five descriptors of God in his teaching:

- He is the Creator (vs 24)
- He is the Ruler (vs 24)
- He is a Giver (vs 25)
- He is the Controller (vs 26)
- He is the Revealer (vs 27-29)
