Luke 24:33-43

The followers of Jesus had a hard time understanding the missing body of Jesus. They were convinced after seeing the resurrected Lord.

If Jesus didn't rise from the dead then His Words nor the rest of Scripture can be believed. All of redemptive history hinges on the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Do you see how the belief of the resurrection is necessary for salvation? Why?

Does your hope come from the fact that our Lord is alive today?

GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE

The first century church was started by a group of people who were witnesses of the resurrection. Without this witness the church doesn't begin.
