Luke 23:33-49

All of redemptive history leads to the cross. Everything before the cross pointed toward the cross. Everything since the cross points back to the cross. All of history hinges on the cross of Jesus.

Jesus is King, but was mocked for claiming to be a king. Christ didn't conquer their enemies like they anticipated, but ultimately He conquered Satan. Spend time in prayer considering that truth.
