1st Corinthians 7:17-24

We are given two primary callings in our life: a vertical call in our salvation, a horizontal call in the way we relate to those who exist in our life circumstances.

When was your primary calling in Christ? Can you share a story of when faith became real in your life?

How much has your salvation impacted your horizontal calling? Has it effected your job? Other relationships? Habits?

Paul teaches that your salvation doesn't mean you have to leave your unbelieving spouse or even quit your job. But to be faithful in your calling.

Have you ever dealt with discontent in your job? Is that created by your lack of feeling most used by the Lord? How does this text help you?

Outside of sin, does this text help you know that you can be a faithful follower of Jesus in whatever context the Lord has brought you to?
