## 1st Corinthians 3:18-23

**Paul finishes the part of the letter where he encourages the church maintain unity and walk in the wisdom of God instead of the wisdom of man.**

What unites you to other Christians? What divides you from other Christians? Are those issues biblical or secular?

Walking in the wisdom of God is "skillful living in Christlikeness." How is this grown in us? Can you understand wisdom as something that is expressed in activity and not just in mentality?

Often we walk in a wisdom based on where we place our identity. Where do you place your identity? Is it in creation or the Creator?

Paul says "the world, life, and death are yours." What does he mean by this? How is it valuable to understand the gifts of creation as something that belongs to you instead of something that you belong to?

Can you give examples of areas of your life that doesn't show the wisdom of God in the way that you live and behave? Can you identify ways to grow in those rhythms?
