Acts 24:1-27

The spread of the gospel during the first century crossed many different lines. Geographical lines, ethnic lines, economic lines, and religious lines. But not all who heard the gospel received it well. Our text covers another lost opportunity.

By chapter 24 Paul had been a believer for about 20 years. Can you describe some of the people who have become believers through his ministry? What are ways the Holy Spirit was at work?

The Father has gotten Paul in front of the governor, Felix. How is God's providence on display in this text?

Can you name any of God's promises? How are they important to remember during difficult circumstances?

Circumstances don't influence the fulfillment of God's promises, but often God uses circumstances to fulfill His promises.

What was Paul actually guilty of? Are you guilty of this as well?

Felix heard the gospel, realized his guilt, and rejected the truth of God's love. Why is it difficult for some to receive Jesus?

Before Paul gave the gospel, he gave the law, because before the good news comes, there has to be an understanding of the bad news- RC Sproul C
