



Am I following God's for my life?

Self-examination invites God-examination

Jeremiah 20:12a (NLT) O Lord of Heaven's Armies, you test those who are righteous, and you examine the deepest thoughts and secrets.

Psalm 139:23-24 (NLT) ²³ Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. ²⁴ Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life.

Psalm 26:2 (NLT) ² Put me on trial, Lord, and cross-examine me. Test my motives and my heart.

1 Corinthians 11:28 (NLT) ²⁸ That is why you should examine yourself before eating the bread and drinking the cup.

Job 13:23 (NLT) ²³ Tell me, what have I done wrong? Show me my rebellion and my sin.

Lamentations 3:40 (NLT) ⁴⁰ Instead, let us test and examine our ways. Let us turn back to the Lord.

Psalm 119:59 (NLT) ⁵⁹ I pondered the direction of my life, and I turned to follow your laws.

Getting to the bottom of the question - Psalm 139:1-18

¹⁶You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed. ¹⁷How precious are your thoughts about me, O God. They cannot be numbered! ¹⁸I can't even count them; they outnumber the grains of sand! And when I wake up, you are still with me!

Romans 12:2 (NLT) ² Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you

will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Jeremiah 29:10-14 (NLT) ¹⁰ This is what the Lord says: "You will be in Babylon for seventy years. But then I will come and do for you all the good things I have promised, and I will bring you home again. ¹¹ For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. ¹² In those days when you pray, I will listen. ¹³ If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me. ¹⁴ I will be found by you," says the Lord. "I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes. I will gather you out of the nations where I sent you and will bring you home again to your own land."

Acts 26:14 (NLT) ¹⁴We all fell down, and I heard a voice saying to me in Aramaic, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me? It is useless for you to fight against my will.'

Proverbs 3:5 (NLT) ⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.
