1. God's power is the source of everything we need.

2 Peter 1:3 (NLT)

³ By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence.

Ephesians 1:19-20 (NLT)

¹⁹ I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him. This is the same mighty power ²⁰ that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms.

Philippians 2:13 (NLT)

¹³ For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him.

What God requires, His power supplies.

2. God has supplied everything necessary for Godly living.

2 Peter 1:3-4 (NLT)

³ By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. ⁴ And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires.

Hebrews 13:20-21 (NLT)

²⁰ Now may the God of peace—
who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus,
the great Shepherd of the sheep,
and ratified an eternal covenant with his blood—

²¹ may he equip you with all you need

for doing his will.

May he produce in you,
through the power of Jesus Christ,
every good thing that is pleasing to him.
All glory to him forever and ever! Amen.

2 Corinthians 9:8 (NLT)

⁸And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.

You have what you need to obey.

3. Because God has supplied it, we must intentionally grow.

2 Peter 1:5-8 (NLT)

⁵In view of all this, make every effort to respond to God's promises. Supplement your faith with a generous provision of moral excellence, and moral excellence with knowledge, ⁶and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with patient endurance, and patient endurance with godliness, ⁷and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love for everyone.

⁸The more you grow like this, the more productive and useful you will be in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:10 (NLT)

¹⁰But whatever I am now, it is all because God poured out his special favor on me—and not without results. For I have worked harder than any of the other apostles; yet it was not I but God who was working through me by his grace.

James 2:17 (NLT)
