



2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT) ¹⁶ All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to <u>teach us</u> what is true and to <u>make us realize what is wrong in our lives</u>. It <u>corrects us when</u> we are wrong and <u>teaches us to do what is right</u>. ¹⁷ God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

Hebrews 4:12 (NLT) ¹² For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. <u>It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires</u>.

Psalm 119:105 (NLT) 105 Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path.

John 1:6-9; 1, 14a (NLT) ⁶God sent a man, John the Baptist, ⁷to tell about the light so that everyone might believe because of his testimony. ⁸John himself was not the light; he was simply a witness to tell about the light. ⁹The one who is the true light, who gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.

¹In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Psalm 119:9 (NLT) 'How can a young person stay pure? By obeying your word.

Deuteronomy 32:47 (NLT) ⁴⁷ These instructions are not empty words—they are your life! By obeying them you will enjoy a long life in the land you will occupy when you cross the Jordan River."

Luke 11:28 (NLT) ²⁸ Jesus replied, "But even more blessed are all who hear the word of God and put it into practice."

John 14:15 (NLT) 15 "If you love me, obey my commandments.

James 1:22 (NLT) ²² But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves.

Psalm 119:106 (NLT) ¹⁰⁶ I've promised it once, and I'll promise it again: I will obey your righteous regulations.
