- 1. Discuss the idea that God's power and help comes from trusting Him even when we are tempted to give –up on our faith.
- 2. Discuss the idea that those who follow Jesus are likely to experience opposition and adversity in this life. (John 16:33)
- 3. The concept might be big, but discuss the fact that Jesus plans to return for His church. What questions does this generate? Why then does it mean we must be very careful in how we live?
- 4. Take some time pray together.
