- 1. Today in our study of Revelation, we will be looking at the portion of scripture that often draws the most attention when studying end time events, "The Great 7 Year Tribulation."
  - a. Daniel 12:1 tells us the tribulation will be a time unlike anything this world has ever seen before.
- 2. But before we dive into the doom, gloom, and fireworks, I think it's important for us to remember...
  - a. Bible prophecy is not meant to scare you but prepare you.
    - Jesus return is a reality!
  - b. We are blessed when we read Revelation.
    - i. Revelation 1:3 <u>God blesses</u> the one who <u>reads</u> the words of this prophecy to the church, and He blesses all who <u>listen</u> to its message and <u>obey</u> what it says, for the time is near.
- 3. So, as we dive into this, here is a simple layout of Revelation.
  - a. Last week I broke into 4 Main Sections, this week I have broken those sections down into more detailed segments. (Show Slide)
    - i. Revelation 1-3: Church Age (present age).
    - ii. Revelation 4:1-2 "Caught Up" Rapture of the Saints.
    - iii. Revelation 4-5: Worship in Heaven.
    - iv. Revelation 6-18: The Great 7 Year Tribulation.
    - v. Revelation 19-20: Defeat of Satan and all Evil.
    - vi. Revelation 21-22: New Heaven and Earth.
  - b. (Show Slide) SIMPLE End Time Event Timeline.
    - i. I want to show you this, because I believe we, who love and live for Christ, will be in heaven when the events take place upon the earth during the great tribulation.
      - 1. So, let's jump into the scene **IN HEAVEN** Revelation chapter 5:1-7.
      - 2. The significance of this scene is vital to understand because it reminds us of who is in control!
- 4. Read Revelation 5:1-7.
  - i. right hand = ultimate power and authority.
  - b. The 7 sealed scroll contains the writing of God's complete plan and destiny of the world.
    - i. This scroll contains the end judgements upon all evil and the eternal inheritance of the body of Christ.

- c. No heavenly angel, or natural human can break the seal. It's specifically addressed to Christ and Christ alone.
  - i. All authority has been given to Christ in heaven and on earth! (Matthew 28:18)
  - ii. Christ is the only way, truth, and life.
    - 1. Revelation is the revealing of Christ from High Priest to King of Kings!
      - a. From lamb to lion!
- d. So when Jesus breaks the Seven sealed scroll, THEN the systematic judgements of the great tribulation begin.
  - i. These judgements are broken into groups of 7's.
    - 1. 7 Seals, 7 Trumpets, 7 Bowls.
- 5. **7 Seals.** (Revelation 6-8)
  - a. The First four seals contain 4 riders upon a colored horses that ride throughout the tribulation period.
  - b. 1st Seal: The Conqueror on the White Horse. (Rev. 6:2)
    - i. This is Not Christ, but the Anti-Christ!
    - ii. Look at these details...
      - 1. This rider has a crown, BUT Jesus has many crowns. (Rev. 19:12)
      - 2. This rider carries a bow (political conquest), BUT Jesus carries a sword. (Rev. 19:15)
    - iii. Satan always attempts to appear as an angel of light. (2 Cor. 11:14)
      - 1. But Satan is the great deceiver and father of lies.
    - iv. The Anti-Christ, the lawless man (1 Thess. 5:3), will gather many nations together to sign a "peace treaty" with Israel.
      - 1. Dan. 9:27 The moment this treaty is signed, the tribulation begins.
  - c. 2<sup>nd</sup> Seal: The Firey Red Horse. (Rev. 6:4)
    - i. International War and violence.
    - ii. Nations will be wiped out.
      - 1. Daniel 7:8,24, Daniel 8:24-25, Daniel 11:21,24 Bible prophecy the anti-Christ will completely destroy 3 of the 10 nations who originally supported him.
        - a. Why? The Anti-Christ is not a peaceful person. The enemy comes to steal, kill, and destroy.

- d. 3<sup>rd</sup> Seal: The Black Horse. (Rev. 6:5)
  - i. Famine, poverty, and economic collapse due to global war.
  - ii. We complain about how prices are inflated now...Revelation 6:6 a loaf of bread will cost an entire day's wage.
    - 1. The luxury of oil and wine will be available but not affordable.
      - a. This is all part of the Anti-Christ system in the tribulation.
  - iii. Because guess what...in Revelation 13:16-18, about midpoint of tribulation, you will not be able to buy, unless you take the mark of the beast.
    - 1. But those who take the mark of the beast do not have their names written in the book of life! (Rev. 14:9-10)
- e. 4th Seal: The Pale Horse. (Rev. 6:8)
  - i. Death and Hades following this rider...it's the image of the Grim Reaper and Grave digger.
    - 1. The pale horse is widespread death.
  - ii. Revelation 6:8 ¼ of the world population will die due to global war, starvation, and economic collapse.
    - 1. Perspective...8 billion = 2 billion dead.
      - a. MANY people will die during the tribulation unprepared to meet God.
      - b. It's a good time to ask yourself, AM I READY?
- f. 5<sup>th</sup> Seal: The Cries of the Martyrs. (Rev. 6:9)
  - i. People will be saved during the great tribulation, but at a great cost.
    - 1. Christians will be beheaded for their faith.
  - ii. Martyrs also might be those who found out they were following religion rather than having a relationship with Christ and weren't prepared at the rapture when he came.
    - 1. Revelation 7:14 Then he said to me, "These are the ones who died in the great tribulation. They have washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb and made them white.
      - a. We don't know! But we do know people will still be saved during this horrible time upon the earth.

- g. 6<sup>th</sup> Seal: Natural and Cosmic Destruction. (Rev. 6:12)
  - i. Great Earthquake.
  - ii. **Dark Sky** volcanic eruptions that shoot vast amounts of ash and gas into the upper atmosphere causing the sun to be darkened and the moon to appear blood red.
  - iii. **Stars Falling** asteroids falling from the sky and hitting the earth.
  - iv. **Sky Receding** nuclear explosions.
    - 1. Notice God gets peoples attention but not their allegiance.
    - 2. Rather than repent and run to God, they run and hide in caves from the one upon the throne.
- h. 7<sup>th</sup> Seal: The 7th Seal contains the next series of judgements,
  7 Trumpets.
  - i. But what is amazing about this seal is that all of Heaven becomes silent!
  - ii. Think about that for a moment because it just shows us how horrible it will be during the tribulation.
    - 1. Heaven is in awe and suspense for what has taken place and what lies ahead. (Rev. 8:1)
- 6. 7 Trumpets. (Revelation 8-9)
  - a. The trumpet judgements are natural, supernatural, and cosmic signs of devastation and destruction.
  - b. 1st Trumpet: Hailstone and fire mingled with Blood. (Rev. 8:7)
  - c. 2<sup>nd</sup> Trumpet: Great Mountain burning with fire. (Rev. 8:8)
  - d. 3<sup>rd</sup> Trumpet: Asteroid falls and pollutes 1/3 of rivers. (Rev. 8:10)
  - e. 4<sup>th</sup> Trumpet: 1/3 of Sun, moon, stars are darkened. (Rev. 8:12)
  - f. 5<sup>th</sup> Trumpet: The bottomless pit opened releasing demonic spirits, to attack and torment people. (Rev. 9:1)
    - i. People will seek death but not find it!
  - g. 6<sup>th</sup> Trumpet: Fallen angels in the Euphrates are loosed that go out and kill 1/3 of all humans on the earth. (Rev. 9:14-16)
    - i. These Spirits are what Paul called principalities (Ephesians 6:12).
    - ii. Principalities are the highest-ranking demonic angel.
      - 1. They reside and rule over nations.

- 2. Daniel 10:11-13 God heard Daniel's prayer immediately but the prince of the kingdom of Persia (demonic principality) fought in the Spiritual realm for Daniel to receive what he prayed for.
- iii. Who are these fallen angels? See Daniel 7 and Revelation 13
  - 1. Lion = Babylon
  - 2. Bear = Media Persia
  - 3. Leopard = Greece
  - 4. Non-Descriptive = Rome
    - a. Anti-Christ reestablishes old ancient kingdom of the middle east territory.
- iv. But what is most shocking, no one repents!
  - 1. Revelation 9:20-21.
- h. 7<sup>th</sup> Seal: Concludes the trumpet judgements and transitions into the 7 Bowl Judgements.
- 7. **7 Bowls**. (Revelation 16)
  - a. The bowl judgements are the most severe, God's wrath poured out. (Rev. 16:1)
    - i. Some speculate the last 3 ½ years but the bible is not specific. We just know throughout the 7-year great tribulation, the judgments gets progressively more severe.
  - b. 1st Bowl: Boils and sores break out upon those who receive the mark of the beast. (Rev. 16:2)
  - c. 2<sup>nd</sup> Bowl: Seas turned into blood, killing all within them. (Rev. 16:3)
  - d. 3<sup>rd</sup> Bowl: Fresh water and springs turn to blood, cutting off water supply. (Rev. 16:4)
  - e. 4th Bowl: Increased heat from the Sun! (Rev. 16:8-9)
    - i. This will be unlike anything global warning scientists have ever seen.
  - f. 5<sup>th</sup> Bowl: Total darkness consumes the land of the anti-Christ. (Rev. 16:10)
    - i. Similar what happened to Pharoah in Egypt (Exodus 10:21-23)
  - g. 6<sup>th</sup> Bowl: 1,800 Mile River Euphrates dries up so that armies of many nations can cross for battle.

- i. We know this is the end battle of Armageddon. (Rev. 16:12-16)
  - 1. Fun fact: Euphrates River has already begun drying up in parts and places in the middle east.
- h. 7<sup>th</sup> Bowl: The greatest earthquake this world has ever seen followed by 100-pound hail falling from the sky! (Rev. 16:18, 21)

## 8. Closing.

- a. Studying the events that will soon take place in the tribulation are not meant to be a scare tactic, but a prepare tactic.
  - i. Jesus is returning! He is coming at a day and hour no man knows. (See Matthew 24:36)
- b. Revelation is to remind and prepare our hearts to stand before Jesus Christ because both righteous and un-righteous will be judged.
  - i. My prayer for each of you here today is to stand before Christ and hear the words well done my good and faithful servant. (see Matthew 25:14-30)
