we have given the idea "unleash hell" a lot of power, strength, intimidation
BUT these verses show us that he'll has not power- they shudder

Victory, strength, courage, power, resolve, intimidation are summed up by

☁️ Unleash Heaven ☁️

The more terrifying phrase should be "Unleash Heaven"

Gideon is not the hero, but really Jesus - angel of the Lord

📖 Judges 6:25-27

Gideon knew he would get attention for from this command from God.

👣 A step toward obedience = a person God can use. Take a step!!!!

Before the declare war on Midian they are going to declare war on Baal
- you have to deal with your home first.

🔥 the battle at home is the first and most important battle. 🔥

What altars need to come down in your home- what sin, what routines, what past
influences on your life(things started by family members) ITS TIME TO DECLARE
WAR

When you begin to declare war on your home privately, people will notice and
people will not be happy.

🏠 As for me and my house we will serve the Lord- when you do this no one will
celebrate you. It exposes the sun that is thriving in other peoples homes and it
makes them uncomfortable.

💡 When you confront sin in your home it will oftentimes ignite the pilot light of faith
in others.

⚠️ ⚠️ Notice how the enemy multiplies, when you declare war on sin, and operate in
obedience the enemy is going to multiple his efforts to destroy you.

But the spirit of the Lord clothed Gideon
