What does this look like for us?

1. Selected

You have been selected but so has your neighbor,

We must believe in a dual citizenship membership.

Horizontal (your country, your city, the people around you) vs. vertical citizenship (with your Heavenly Father, body of Christ, members of the Kingdom of God)

What is my responsibility to share the gospel, to believe in miracles, to pray boldly

2. Sanctified

You have been made holy

This is the primary work of the Holy Spirit inside of you

Christian Growth is not this: a straight line up Christian Growth is more of a squiggly line

The sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit in us is what's pulling us along

Matthew 16- who do you think I am? Vs 16,18,23

3. Sprinkled Hebrews 9

There is only power in the blood of Jesus without him none of this is worth it
