

& Week 2 | Frankincense and Myrrh

Matthew 2:2 , John 19:19 $\,\rightarrow$ They came to worship Him Matthew 2:11

You don't worship a baby You don't worship a person You worship God!!!

Frankincense was very expensive, used for perfume and cosmetics, was used as the oil that the priests would use during the sacrifices to burn in the altar.

Exodus 30:34-35 Frankincense was a gift for the divine.

John 1:1, John 20:28 Prophetically pointing to the divinity of God

Frankincense points to the divine nature of Jesus, but also the divine purpose of Jesus.

AGIOS - means separate, or other than. God is transcendently separate. Our God is holy, but the problem is: we are not!!!

Hebrews 4:14-15 || This is GOOD NEWS!!!

Hebrews 4:16 - If God is Holy and we are not, how are we able to approach His throne with boldness? *God is our great high priest and Jesus is our mediator.*
