Don't think that when God has allowed bad things to happen that he has abandoned you. He hasn't.

Maintain your call to righteousness!!!

In order for the church to be healthy, the home has to be healthy.

Godly leadership - 1 Peter 5:2-11

Your home and your kids are not just by default God has entrusted you sheep to you.

Holy Leadership: We lead by going before them, showing them the way, modeling forgiveness + worship, to stand in righteous opposition to the world...

Vs. 4: you lead this way because the Great shepherd is coming.

Sheep are defenseless- they need help - they are prone to wonder

This is not a call to become a helicopter parent - we guard their soul, but we need to let them take risks...
