Revelation - What God did, who He is...

- 1. Acts 2:22, 36 = Son of God, Emmanuel, Lord, Messiah
- Acts 2:23, 36 = Died/Crucified,
 (Gen 3:15; Psalm 2, 22; Isaiah 52, 53;
 Dan 2)

- 3. Acts 2:24 -32 = Raised / Resurrected (Romans 6)
- 4. Acts 2:33-35 = Jesus is Exalted / Glorified (Psalm 110; Ephesians 1:20-2:9)
