Corinth

- **1.** Rebelled against Roman rule in 146BC rebuilt as a Roman Colony 46BC.
- 2. Homer's Iliad (9th century B.C.).
- **3.** "Corinth" came to imply licentiousness. "Corinthianize" = to live in debauchery.
- 4. Founded the church Acts 18:1-18.
- 5. Lost misunderstood letter? (1 Cor 5:9-10).

Corinth

Three Visits:

- 1) When church was founded;
- 2) The "painful" visit;
- 3) A visit after 2 Corinthians had been sent.

Four letters:

- 1) The "Previous Letter"; 2) 1 Corinthians;
- 3) The "Severe Letter"; 4) 2 Corinthians.

Problems

- 1. Division (1–4).
- 2. Discipline (5–6).
- 3. Divorce and Marriage (7).
 - 4. Doctrinal disputes (8–10).
- 5. Demonstrative gifts (12–14).
