Disciple = apprentice μαθητής (G3101) (mathēteuō)

- intransitively, to become a pupil; transitively, to disciple, i.e. enrol as scholar:
- —be disciple, instruct, teach.
- (See Mat 28:19)



- 18 Jesus came near and spoke to them, "I've received all authority in heaven and on earth.

Church =

ἐκκλησία (ekklēsia) = Called Out Ones

- a gathering of people called out from their homes into some public place, an assembly. (See Mat 16:18, 1st Cor 1:2, etc.)

έπισυναγωγή (episynagoge) = Assembly

- a Christian meeting (for worship), a gathering together in one place, to come to the side of. (Heb
