Westminster Shorter Catechism

Q. 93. Which are the sacraments of the New Testament?

The sacraments of the New Testament are, two only, Baptism, and the Lord's Supper, and these take the place of Circumcision and the Passover in the Old Testament.

Q. 94. What is Baptism?
