Why do we do the Lord's Supper?

John 6:41-58

For what is the supper except a visible and manifest witness to the promise in the sixth chapter of St. John, which is that "Christ is the bread of life which came down from heaven" (Jn. 6:51)? So the visible bread must be a sign by which the spiritual bread is set out in a figure for us, unless we want to destroy all the fruit of the sacrament and the comfort which our Lord gave us in it in order to support our weakness. For as the inward purification of the soul is more certified to the hearts of the faithful when it is indicated by the external washing of water in baptism, so also the bread in the supper is important to witness to us about the spiritual nourishment which we have in the body of Christ – **John Calvin**




