Westminster Shorter Catechism Q. 16. Did all mankind fall in Adam's first disobedience?

Since the covenant of life was made with Adam for his descendants as well as for himself, all mankind descending from him in the ordinary manner, sinned in him, and fell with him in his first transgression.

The Covenant of Grace

- What do we learn in 1 Corinthians 15:45?
- Who are the parties in the covenant of grace? How is this different than the covenant of works?
 - o Romans 5:19-20
 - Hebrews 8:5
 - "Where Adam collapsed, Jesus conquered. Where Adam compromised, Jesus refused to negotiate.
 Where Adam's trust in God faltered, Jesus' never wavered. The second Adam triumphed for Himself and for us." R.C. Sproul
 - "Man, by his fall, having made himself incapable of life by that covenant, the Lord was pleased to make a second, commonly called the covenant of grace; wherein He freely offers unto sinners life and salvation by Jesus Christ; requiring of them faith in Him, that they may be saved, and promising to give unto all those that are ordained unto eternal life His Holy Spirit, to make them willing, and able to believe." - Westminster Confession of Faith 7.3
