

Discussion Questions

- What Bible story/passages stick out in your mind? Why?
- Do you believe most people view the crucifixion in terms of the physical (beating, act of crucifixion) or the spiritual (bearing the weight of sin and God's wrath)? Why?
- 3. Are you surprised by the reaction of the disciples (Peter's denial, the three falling asleep, and eventually scattering when Jesus is arrested)?
- 4. What are some practical steps we can take to prepare ourselves for the trials which will inevitably come?
- Jesus' temptation in the garden could be seen as a watershed moment in the life of Jesus. What other watershed events occurred in the story of redemption?
- 6. When has God used a trial in your life to help you grow in your faith?
